At risk children require a dose of Pneumovax 23 (pneumococcal) at 2-12 months after Prevenar 13 or at age 4 years whichever is later.

All children aged 6 months to less than 5 years are recommended to receive the annual influenza vaccine (NIP funded)*.

Children aged 6 months to less than 9 years of age require 2 doses at least 4 weeks apart in their first year of influenza vaccination.
