MANDATORY REPORTING OF THE HEPATITIS B VACCINE BIRTH DOSE



Please share this information with all relevant staff in your facility

- 1. Hepatitis B vaccine is funded and recommended at birth or within the first 7 days of life to prevent disease transmission from an infected mother or other household member
- 2. From 1 July 2021, immunisation providers are required to report ALL vaccinations, including the Hepatitis B vaccine birth dose, to the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) within 10 working days
- 3. Immunisation providers must register for a PRODA account to ensure continued access to the AIR, including to report vaccinations for new patients without a Medicare number (such as babies)

Mandated reporting to the AIR

 New Australian Government legislation requires that immunisation providers report ALL vaccinations to the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) within 10 working days after vaccination, including the hepatitis B vaccine birth dose

Hepatitis B vaccine birth dose

- Individuals who do not have a Medicare number (such as babies) can still have vaccinations recorded on the AIR using existing practice software or alternatively the AIR Secure Site
- The AIR Site allows for the recording of a new patient (those without a Medicare number) and immunisation providers are encouraged to add as much detail as possible to these records to allow for future matching, including: First and last names (if known), Address, Date of Birth and Postcode
- These individuals will be recorded on the AIR and given a supplementary identification number (SIN) that can be used for subsequent immunisation encounters or until a Medicare registration has been completed

Registering for PRODA

- From 30 September 2021, the current authentication file process to access the AIR will be closed off and replaced with PRODA (Provider Digital Access)
- A PRODA account allows health professionals to access the AIR using Health Professionals Online Services (HPOS)
- All providers and their delegates need to register for PRODA. If you access the AIR as a member of an organisation, you can also find out how to register an organisation in PRODA and link HPOS to your organisation so members can access the AIR
