Our Idea Comes to Life

- To turn a paper based training resource into an accessible and interactive online program
- Establish an interface between clinicians and IT
- Initial pilot program ran for 10 months in 2007
- 2011 funding gained to employ small dedicated team
- This team reviewed, redeveloped, updated and redesigned the resource
- The result: a high quality evidence based training and resource platform available to NSW clinicians
