- Reduce chronic care of scar tissue





13 year old male with acquired cutis laxa (destruction of elastin)


# Elastin is enriched in the deep dermis

### NSW Health MDF Funding



- \$2 million from NSW MDF over a two year period
- Development of the Elastinised Dermal Template
- Drive product to regulatory approval in 2015

## **Practical Steps**




- Clinical input into treatment design and endpoints
