Registration of Professional Personnel

This emphasises again the need for hospitals to check the Registration of all professional and trained staff who require a certificate to work. It cannot be too strongly stressed the serious consequences of utilising either untrained or unregistered health personnel.

It must be a strict rule that no staff are to be employed before qualifications and current registration are confirmed and systems must exist within hospitals to ensure that all persons employed in the professions listed hereunder maintain current registration.
