AMBULANCE SERVICE OF NSW DEATH AND DISABILITY (STATE) AWARD – HEALTH AND WELLNESS PROGRAM

PURPOSE

The Ambulance Service of NSW Death and Disability (State) Award has been varied through arbitration by a Full Bench of the Industrial Relations Commission on 8 September 2009. In accordance with the Leave Reserved Clause, the Department had made application to vary the Award to insert provisions for a Health and Wellness Program.

KEY INFORMATION

The variation incorporates into the Award a Health and Wellness Program which will commence to be implemented from 1 July 2010. The variations to the Award are:

- Revised Clause 11, Health and Wellness Program.
- New Annexure D to the Award, Ambulance Service of NSW Health and Wellness Program.

The Ambulance Service and the Health Services Union will further consult on the Health and Wellness Program to establish the operation and practical application of the program consistent with Annexure D to the Award. The Ambulance Service will commence to implement the Program from 1 July 2010.
