

## Mental Health Bed Types for Inpatient Units 2006/2007

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Clinical/ Patient Services - Information and data

**Summary** This Policy Directive outlines the authorised bed type codes for inpatient mental health units for implementation on 1 July 2006. This Policy Directive also outlines the authorised Mental Health Sub-Program and DOHRS Institution Type for reporting for all inpatient mental health units.

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## **AUTHORISED LIST OF MENTAL HEALTH BED TYPES FOR INPATIENT UNITS 2006/2007**

### **1. Introduction**

This Policy Directive outlines the authorised bed type codes for inpatient mental health units, for implementation from 1 July 2006.

This Policy Directive also outlines the authorised Mental Health Sub Program and DOHRS Institution Type for reporting for all inpatient mental health units.

This policy directive should be distributed to all staff involved in the maintenance of inpatient Patient Administration Systems (PASs). This includes those who develop and manage the statewide PASs, and those who manage the PASs at the hospitals (e.g. medical record staff).

### **2. Purpose**

There have been some reported discrepancies between the official Mental Health and Drug & Alcohol Office codes for Bed Types in mental health inpatient units and what the hospitals have specified within their Patient Administration Systems for extract to the HIE.

Accurate monitoring of Inpatient activity and resources (Beds) for all of the components of the Mental Health Program requires the accurate coding in Patient Administration Systems (PAS), of Bed Type, Financial Program, Financial sub program and service category.

This is particularly critical in terms of available bed numbers, which are a constant subject of Parliamentary questions and ministerial briefings.

Correct bed type classification is also essential for the monitoring of type of mental health care that the patient is receiving during his/her stay in hospital. It allows the Mental Health and Drug & Alcohol Office to monitor bed numbers and activity for specialist wards in psychiatric and general hospitals, and provides the ability to monitor client level inpatient activity by a variety of bed/unit types.

Given the quality of current DOHRS reports, from which the SEAB reports are sourced, the Mental Health and Drug & Alcohol Office has concerns about the current quality and accuracy of the coding for these data items in local systems.

To eliminate any further confusion, the Mental Health and Drug & Alcohol Office has developed a statewide matrix of coding for mental health inpatient units that identifies all authorised inpatient units and defines their bed type, DOHRS reporting attributes and financial program structure, for implementation into the hospital PASs.

### 4. Assignment of Bed Type, Financial Program/Subprogram & Institution Type

4.1 Each PAS (HOSPAS, WinPAS, Cerner and iPM) will have their own way to assign bed type, usually sourced from a reference table within the application. In all cases, the assignment of bed type must conform to the authorised bed type list as described in Section 3.

4.2 **Hospitals are prohibited from creating local bed types for mental health beds.** Any creation of local bed types lead to issues of accurate mapping to the state authorised bed types, causing incorrect analysis of data based upon bed type. **All hospitals must use the authorised set of mental health bed types for all mental health beds.** The only exception to this is the creation of bed type/subprogram combinations (as per iPM INCLI: Clinical Intensity reference table). However, any mappings must be submitted to the Mental Health and Drug & Alcohol Office for approval. For the list of authorised iPM Bed Type code and mappings for mental health bed types, see **Appendix A**.

4.3 Each bed type must be assigned a mental health subprogram code. For those systems that can create bed type/subprogram combinations (eg iPM), this is acceptable, so long as the financial subprogram information is supplied to the Health Information Exchange (HIE). For systems such as HOSPAS where this is not possible, subprograms are assigned to the ward.

4.4 For those wards with multiple subprograms within the one ward, where the PAS does not allow bed type/subprogram combinations, it is recommended that a virtual ward be created in order to capture the subprogram for those mental health beds.

4.5 Regarding DOHRS Institution Type, this is usually derived within the HIE. The authorised Institution Type HIE calculations are listed in **Appendix B**.

## 5. Sub Programs Definitions and applications

5.1 All mental health bed types should have a mental health subprogram code associated with them. These codes are B (Child and Adolescent), C (General & Adult), D (Older Persons) and E (Forensic). **Please note that these subprograms are attributes of the service, not of the patient.** In other words, just because a person aged 75 is admitted to a mental health bed, it doesn't automatically change the subprogram to D. If the principal service that the inpatient unit provides is General & Adult, the subprogram remains set to C. The only exception to this is for CAMHS patients (see Section 7).

5.2 The Mental Health Subprograms are defined as follows:

5.2.1 **Child & Adolescent Mental Health:** A specialist psychiatric/mental health service unit/staff person that principally targets children and young people up to the age of 18 years.

5.2.2 **General and Adult Mental Health:** A specialist psychiatric/mental health service unit/staff person, which provides general psychiatry services to the general adult population but may provide services to children, adolescents or the aged in special circumstances when more appropriate service provision is unavailable.

5.2.3 **Older People Psychiatric Care (Admitted or Non-admitted Patients):** A specialist psychiatric/mental health service unit/staff person, which principally targets people in the age group 65 years and over.

5.2.4 **Forensic Mental Health:** A specialist psychiatric/mental health unit/staff person which assesses, treats or cares for mentally disordered individuals whose condition has led them to commit criminal offences or makes it likely that they will offend in the future if not adequately treated or contained.

Forensic Units are those that have been specifically set up to deal with patients who are:

- a) currently admitted in an inpatient mental health unit within the Justice Health service; or
- b) those patients who are currently outside of the Justice Health service, but are still considered as 'forensic' (eg, an individual who has been released from a Justice facility, and who is now admitted to a community residential facility that has been set up to manage forensic patients, or an individual who has been found not guilty by reason of mental illness and is admitted to an inpatient forensic unit); or
- c) those patients who, as a result of their mental illness, are at risk of coming into contact with the Justice system.

5.3 While mental health units are set up to deal with a specific population subgroup, these units may indeed see patients from any of the population subgroups. It is important to remember, however, that the subgroup is an attribute of the service, **NOT** the patient.

5.4 Additionally, even if a mental health unit has been set up locally to deal with a specific population subgroup, it must also be funded from that financial subprogram before it can officially be attributed to it.

## **6. Type Change Instructions**

6.1 Where a patient is transferred from an acute mental health inpatient unit to a rehabilitation or an extended care inpatient unit (or visa versa), this requires a change in Service Category, from '1 – Acute Care' to '2 – Rehabilitation Care', or visa versa.

6.2 Where this has occurred, this is a new episode of care. Therefore the patient **MUST** be statistically separated and readmitted within the PAS. The rules for this are described within the Admitted Patient Data Dictionary (<http://internal.health.nsw.gov.au/im/ims/ap/ap-data-dictionary-current-public.html>), and must be complied with for all psychiatric hospitals with multiple mental health inpatient units.

## **7. Specific Constraints on Bed Type Codes**

### **7.1 Bed Type 06 (Psychiatric Secure)**

7.1.1 Currently, this bed type **cannot** be assigned to any child & adolescent inpatient units (Subprogram B).

### **7.2 Bed Type 13 (Post Natal Depression)**

7.2.1 Currently, this bed type can only be assigned to adult & general inpatient units (Subprogram C).

### **7.3 Bed Type 21 (Neuro-Psychiatry)**

7.3.1 Currently, this bed type can only be assigned to adult & general inpatient units (Subprogram C).

### **7.4 Bed Type 22 (Dual Diagnosis)**

7.4.1 Currently, this bed type can only be assigned to adult & general inpatient units (Subprogram C).

### **7.5 Bed Type 24 (Confused and Disturbed Elderly - Psychiatric)**

7.5.1 Currently, this bed type **cannot** be assigned to any child & adolescent inpatient units (Subprogram B).

## **7.6 Bed Type 28 (Hospital in the Home - Mental Health)**

7.6.1 The Mental Health and Drug & Alcohol Office (MHDAO) does not support the use of Bed Type 28, and it **must not** be used by any hospital as a bed type. Any activities carried out in the client's home are classified as ambulatory, not inpatient.

## **7.7 Bed Type 50 (Psychiatric Medium Secure)**

7.7.1 The MHDAO has identified that this code has a substantial overlap with Bed Type code 06 (Psychiatric Secure). As there are no funding or staffing differences between these two beds types, and in the absence of any substantial definitional differences, the MHDAO has authorised that no hospital may use this bed type.

7.7.2 Until 2005/06, the only units that were authorised to use this bed type were Bunya at Cumberland Hospital, and Kestral at Morristet Hospital. These are now to be classified as Bed type '06 – Psychiatric Secure'.

## **7.8 Bed Type 56 (Mental Health Social Day Program)**

7.8.1 Currently the only hospital that is authorised to use this bed type is Concord Hospital. Any hospital wishing to use this bed type must notify the Mental Health and Drug & Alcohol Office (MHDAO) in writing, outlining the reasons for the request. In the absence of written authorisation from the MHDAO, no other hospital may use this code under any circumstance.

7.8.2 Currently, this bed type can only be assigned to adult & general inpatient units (Subprogram C).

## **7.9 Bed Type 62 (CAMHS Supported Paediatric)**

7.9.1 CAMHS Supported Paediatric Beds are only coded as 62 when occupied by a child/adolescent with support from a CAMHS staff person. They are not mental health beds and do not count psychiatric care days.

7.9.2 This bed type is not funded through the mental health financial program (Program 8), but is funded through the Acute Services (Program 5). Therefore no subprogram applies.

## **7.10 Bed Type 63 (CAMHS Supported Psychiatric)**

7.10.1 CAMHS Supported Psychiatric Beds are only coded as 63 when occupied by a child/adolescent with support from a CAMHS staff person. They are already existing mental health beds in adult units and do count psychiatric bed bays.

- 7.10.2 When a child/adolescent patient occupies this bed, and is supported by a CAMHS staff person, the financial subprogram changes from adult & general (C) to child & adolescent (B). This is the only circumstance where the financial subprogram changes for a bed type. This is due to the presence of a CAMHS staff person.

## **7.11 Bed Type 73 (Same Day Mental Health)**

- 7.11.1 Most same day mental health hospital activities have been classified by the Mental Health and Drug & Alcohol Office as being ambulatory activities, and therefore are not considered inpatients, precluding the use of this bed type. The only exception to this is for same day ECT patients, for which bed type 73 may be used. However, see 7.11.2.
- 7.11.2 Hospitals who have been funded for acute overnight psychiatric care beds (such as Nepean Hospital) cannot use bed type 73 to classify these beds – they are to remain as bed type 04 'Psychiatric Acute Care'. This bed type is only to be used by hospitals where they have assigned non-mental health funded beds for the purpose of ECT.
- 7.11.3 Currently, this bed type can only be assigned to adult & general inpatient units (Subprogram C).

## **7.12 Bed Type 85 (Psychiatric Emergency Care Centre)**

- 7.12.1 There has been a new bed type created for Psychiatric Emergency Care Centres. This is code '85 – Psychiatric Emergency Care'. Previously they were classified to bed type '04 – Psychiatric Acute Care'.
- 7.12.2 The PECC bed type is only to be used when MH specific beds exist within a separate PECC unit. Until this occurs patients are admitted to the Emergency Department not the PECC (Bed Type 17). Where PECC funding has been used to employ extra specialist staff, all activity of these staff is to be recorded as ambulatory care to admitted patients.
- 7.12.3 Currently, this bed type can only be assigned to adult & general inpatient units (Subprogram C).

## **7.13 Additional notes**

- 7.13.1 Bed type does not change based upon the client who is currently in that bed. If a client is admitted with a psychiatric illness, and is placed in a general bed, that bed type does **not** change as a consequence (except for authorised CAMHS swinging beds). In other words it remains as bed type 01.
- 7.13.2 Definitions for mental health bed types are listed in **Appendix C**.

## **8. Reporting requirements**

To ensure that this policy directive is being complied with, at the beginning of each financial year, each hospital that has a mental health inpatient unit must provide a printout from their Patient Administration System detailing the correct bed code assignment for the inpatient unit. This printout must be signed off by the Area Director of Mental Health Services and submitted to the Mental Health and Drug & Alcohol Office, who will confirm that the Policy Directive has been complied with.

Area Mental Health Information Officers will be able to assist in these tasks.

## **9. Date of compliance submission**

Confirmation of correct bed type classification to be submitted by 31 March 2007.

## APPENDIX C

### Mental Health Bed Type Definitions

Source: (Mental Health Data Dictionary V3 and Admitted Patient Data Dictionary 2005)

**04 - Psychiatric Acute:** A bed staffed 24 hours a day that is designated by the NSW Health Mental Health and Drug & Alcohol Office to accommodate patients who present with acute episodes of mental illness.

**Note:** Beds in this category may be used for a mix of both day stay and overnight patients, but must be staffed for overnight patient care. Beds in this category may not be used for 'overflow patients'. Days spent in this type of bed are counted as "Days in a Designated Psychiatric Unit".

Please note: this is classified as an acute psych bed.

**05 - Psychiatric Rehabilitation:** A bed staffed 24 hours a day that is designated by the NSW Health Mental Health and Drug & Alcohol Office to accommodate patients requiring care which has a primary focus on intervention to reduce functional impairments resulting from psychiatric disorders that limit the independence of patients.

**Note:** Beds in this category may be used for a mix of both day stay and overnight patients, but must be staffed for overnight patient care. Beds in this category may not be used for 'overflow patients'. Days spent in this type of bed are counted as "Days in a Designated Psychiatric Unit".

Please note: this is classified as a non-acute psych bed.

**06 - Psychiatric Secure:** A bed staffed 24 hours a day that is designated by the NSW Health Mental Health and Drug & Alcohol Office to accommodate of forensic patients (or other patients) requiring a higher level of care and containment than other mental health patients. Forensic patients are people with a mental disorder that has led them to commit criminal offences, or makes it likely that they will offend in the future if not adequately treated or contained.

**Note:** Beds in this category may be used for a mix of both day stay and overnight patients, but must be staffed for overnight patient care. Beds in this category may not be used for 'overflow patients'. Days spent in this type of bed are counted as "Days in a Designated Psychiatric Unit".

Please note: this is classified as a non-acute psych bed.

**12 - Psychiatric Intensive Care:** A bed staffed 24 hours a day that is designated by the NSW Health Mental Health and Drug & Alcohol Office to accommodate patients requiring a higher intensity of management than can be readily provided in a general acute psychiatric bed.

These beds are staffed and designed for the accommodation of patients who:

- are severely disturbed and represent a high risk of being a danger to themselves, others or the environment

- present with threatening or violent behaviours and cannot be safely managed in a less restrictive environment
- require higher levels of nursing observation.

**Note:** Beds in this category may be used for a mix of both day stay and overnight patients, but must be staffed for overnight patient care. Beds in this category may not be used for 'overflow patients'. Days spent in this type of bed are counted as "Days in a Designated Psychiatric Unit".

Please note: this is classified as an acute psych bed.

**13 - Post Natal Depression:** A bed staffed 24 hours a day that is designated by the NSW Health Mental Health and Drug & Alcohol Office to accommodate patients with post natal depression.

**Note:** Beds in this category may be used for a mix of both day stay and overnight patients, but must be staffed for overnight patient care. Beds in this category may not be used for 'overflow patients'. Days spent in this type of bed are counted as "Days in a Designated Psychiatric Unit".

Please note: this is classified as an acute psych bed.

**20 - Psychiatric Extended Care:** A bed staffed 24 hours a day that is designated by the NSW Health Mental Health and Drug & Alcohol Office to accommodate patients who require care over an indefinite period because they have a stable but severe level of functional impairment and an inability to function independently and thus require extensive care and support.

**Note:** Beds in this category may be used for a mix of both day stay and overnight patients, but must be staffed for overnight patient care. Beds in this category may not be used for 'overflow patients'. Days spent in this type of bed are counted as "Days in a Designated Psychiatric Unit".

Please note: this is classified as a non-acute psych bed.

**21 - Neuro-psychiatry:** A bed staffed 24 hours a day that is designated by the NSW Health Mental Health and Drug & Alcohol Office to accommodate patients who require neuro-psychiatric care. These beds are attended by specialists in Neurology or Neuropsychiatry.

**Note:** Beds in this category may be used for a mix of both day stay and overnight patients, but must be staffed for overnight patient care. Beds in this category may not be used for 'overflow patients'. Days spent in this type of bed are counted as "Days in a Designated Psychiatric Unit".

Please note: this is classified as an acute psych bed.

**22 - Dual Diagnosis:** A bed staffed 24 hours a day that is designated by the NSW Health Mental Health and Drug & Alcohol Office to accommodate patients who require specialist care for co-existing mental health and substance use disorders.

**Note:** Beds in this category may be used for a mix of both day stay and overnight patients, but must be staffed for overnight patient care. Beds in this category may not be used for 'overflow patients'. Days spent in this type of bed are counted as "Days in a Designated Psychiatric Unit".

Please note: this is classified as an acute psych bed.

**24 - Confused and Disturbed Elderly (CADE) - Psychiatric:** A bed staffed 24 hours a day, designated by the Area Health Service to provide residential nursing home care to geriatric patients displaying challenging behaviours which would make them unsuitable for admission to a general residential aged care facility or live independently in the community. These beds are considered to be Residential Aged Care beds, not admitted patient beds, however they are State funded. These beds are funded under the Mental Health Financial Program.

**Note:** Patients accommodated in these beds are residents, and thus will be overnight patients apart from exceptional circumstances (for example, death on the day of commencing their stay). Beds in this category may not be used for 'overflow patients'. Days spent in this type of bed are counted as "Days in a Designated Psychiatric Unit". As these beds are not admitted patient beds, there may be no ward transfers to or from this Bed Type – only formal admissions and formal discharges to and from this Bed Type are permitted.

**32 - Collaborative Care Service Provider – Mental Health:** A "virtual" bed established on the patient administration system to record mental health admitted patient activity provided by another public or private hospital under a collaborative (or contract) care arrangement.

**Note:** The days the patient is accommodated in these beds counts towards the patient days for both the purchasing facility and the facility providing the collaborative care service.

Please note: this is classified as an acute psych bed.

**54 - Mental Health Community Residential (24 hour staffing):** A bed designated to accommodate mental health community residential care clients in a unit staffed 24 hours a day.

**Note:** It is not a requirement for community residential activity to be recorded on a patient administration system, however where it is the activity must be clearly identified by a community residential care bed type so that it is not counted as admitted patient activity. Beds in this category may not be used for 'overflow patients'. Ward transfers transactions to this Bed Type are not permitted, rather a formal discharge and formal admission transaction must be performed.

**55 - Mental Health Community Residential (< 24 hour staffing):** A bed designated to accommodate mental health community residential care clients in a unit that is not staffed 24 hours a day.

**Note:** It is not a requirement for community residential activity to be recorded on a patient administration system, however where it is the activity must be clearly identified by a community residential care bed type so that it is not counted as admitted patient activity. Beds in this category may not be used for 'overflow patients'. Ward transfers

transactions to this Bed Type are not permitted, rather a formal discharge and formal admission transaction must be performed.

**56 - Mental Health Social Day Program:** A 'virtual' bed established for the purpose of recording mental health social day program activity on a patient administration system.

**Note:** Beds in this category may not be used for 'overflow patients'. Generally, mental health social day program activity should be classified as non-admitted patient care and thus should not be recorded on a patient administration system. However, in a few circumstances this activity is performed on an admitted patient basis under a special arrangement, for example for DVA clients at Concord.

Please note: this is classified as a non-acute psych bed.

**62 - CAMHS Supported Paediatric:** A bed that is staffed 24 hours a day, designated by the facility to be a paediatric bed, that is currently being used to accommodate a child or adolescent mental health patient. While admitted to this bed, care is provided by a specially trained CAMHS nurse.

**Note:** Beds in this category may be used for a mix of both day stay and overnight patients, but must be staffed for overnight patient care. Beds in this category may NOT be used for 'overflow patients'. These beds are 'swinging' beds with beds classified as '43 – Paediatric'. Days spent in this type of bed are **NOT** counted as "Days in a Designated Psychiatric Unit". Patients admitted to beds in this category must be less than 18 years old at the time of formal admission. As this activity is accounted for under Program 5 – Acute Admitted Patient Services, a sub-program is not relevant.

**63 - CAMHS Supported Psychiatric:** A bed that is staffed 24 hours a day, designated by the facility to be a designated adult psychiatric bed, that is currently being used to accommodate a child or adolescent mental health patient.

**Note:** Beds in this category may be used for a mix of both day stay and overnight patients, but must be staffed for overnight patient care. Beds in this category may NOT be used for 'overflow patients'. Days spent in this type of bed are counted as "Days in a Designated Psychiatric Unit". These beds are 'swinging' beds with beds classified designated adult psychiatric beds (such as '04 - Psychiatric Acute Care'). Patients admitted to beds in this category must be less than 18 years old at the time of formal admission. The associated value for the 'Mental Health Financial Sub Program' must be "B".

Please note: this is classified as an acute psych bed.

**64 - CAMHS Acute:** A bed staffed 24 hours a day that is specifically designated by the NSW Health Mental Health and Drug & Alcohol Office to accommodate child or adolescent mental health patients who require acute care.

**Note:** Beds in this category may be used for a mix of both day stay and overnight patients, but must be staffed for overnight patient care. Beds in this category may NOT be used for 'overflow patients'. Days spent in this type of bed are counted as "Days in a Designated Psychiatric Unit". Patients admitted to beds in this category must be less than 18 years old at the time of formal admission. The associated value for the 'Mental Health Financial Sub Program' must be "B".

Please note: this is classified as an acute psych bed.

**65 - CAMHS Non-Acute:** A bed staffed 24 hours a day that is specifically designated by the NSW Health Mental Health and Drug & Alcohol Office to accommodate child or adolescent mental health patients who require non-acute care.

**Note:** Beds in this category may be used for a mix of both day stay and overnight patients, but must be staffed for overnight patient care. Beds in this category may NOT be used for 'overflow patients'. Days spent in this type of bed are counted as "Days in a Designated Psychiatric Unit". Patients admitted to beds in this category must be less than 18 years old at the time of formal admission. The associated value for the 'Mental Health Financial Sub Program' must be "B".

Please note: this is classified as a non-acute psych bed.

**73 - Same Day Mental Health:** A chair or bed staffed for a limited period each a day that is designated by the NSW Health Mental Health and Drug & Alcohol Office for the provision of same day mental health services only.

**Note:** Same Day Mental Health units generally have regular business hours and open and close each day at set times. Beds in this category include those used to for same day ECT services.

Chairs and beds in this category may only be used for patients receiving a mental health service and days spent in this type of bed are counted as "Days in a Designated Psychiatric Unit".

This bed type can be used to temporarily accommodate overnight stay patients however where this occurs the patient must be transferred out to an overnight ward before the end of the business day.

The purpose of this bed type is not to identify same day patients, but instead to identify activity in beds that are not staffed 24 hours a day.

Please note: this is classified as an acute psych bed.

**85 – Psychiatric Emergency Care Centre:** A bed staffed 24 hours a day that is designated by the NSW Health Mental Health and Drug & Alcohol Office to accommodate patients who present to hospital Emergency Departments with acute mental illness and require specialised mental health care and observation prior to disposal (e.g. transportation, transfer to another admitted patient bed, transfer to another designated psychiatric bed or discharge). They may be admitted as either voluntary or involuntary patients under the Mental Health Act. These beds are co located and associated with the Emergency Department of a hospital, however they are funded and staffed under the Mental Health financial program and are available 24hrs a day for use by mental health patients.

**Note:** Beds in this category may be used for a mix of both day stay and overnight patients, but must be staffed for overnight patient care. Beds in this category may not be used for 'overflow patients'. Days spent in this type of bed are counted as "Days in a Designated Psychiatric Unit".

Please note: this is classified as an acute psych bed.
