**Fig 3.1:** Age and sex distribution of all nurses working in NSW, 2000

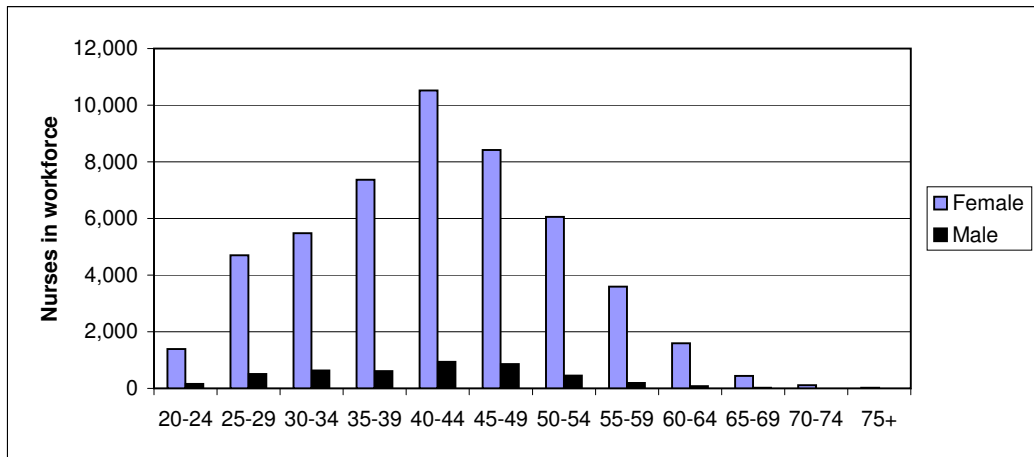

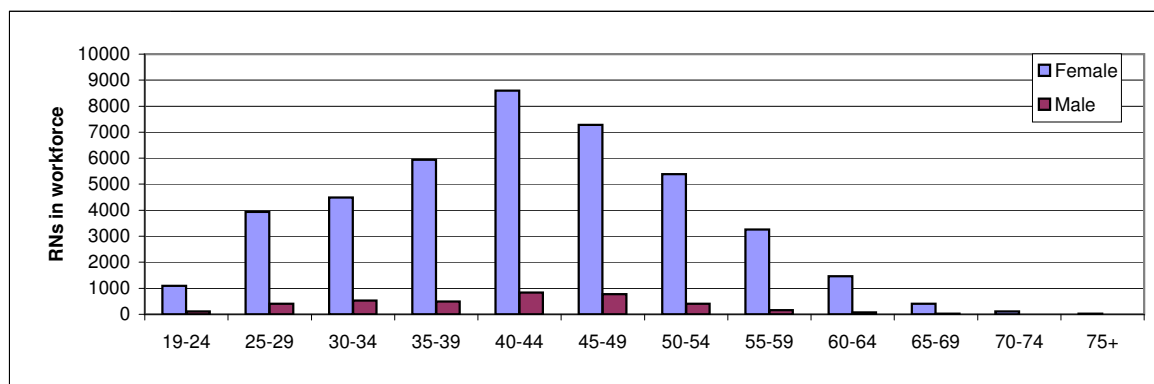

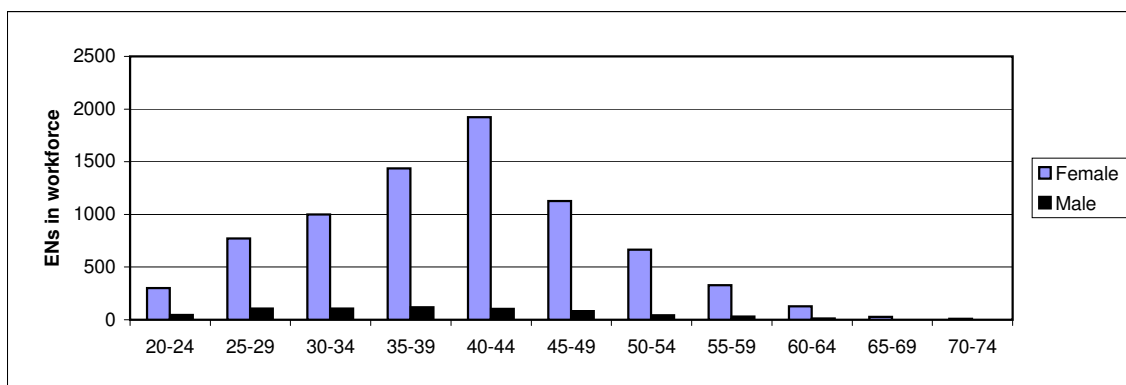
