Oral Health Scheme

You have been issued with a Voucher that allows you to receive priority dental treatment from a participating private dentist who practices in your local area.

A list of [private dentists](#) who have agreed to provide dental treatment under this Scheme can be obtained from your local Public Dental Health Clinic.

You must:

- contact a [private dentist](#) from the list of participating dentists in your local Area to make an appointment.
- tell the [private dentist](#) that you have been referred by a Public Dental Health Clinic and need treatment under the NSW Oral Health Fee for Service Scheme.
- make an appointment with a [private dentist](#) within 10 days of the receiving your voucher.

When you go to your appointment with your [private dentist](#) you must bring:

- your Oral Health Treatment Voucher
- proof of identification and eligibility

You will not be charged for the type of dental treatment authorised on the Voucher.

Any additional treatment offered by the [private dentist](#) outside that authorised on the Voucher should be discussed and clearly understood as this may incur fees payable by yourself.

You will be required to sign the Claim Form on the bottom of the Voucher when treatment is completed.

All vouchers expire within 28 days.

Please contact your Public Oral Health Clinic if:

- you are unable to use the Voucher within 28 days.
- your [private dentist](#) of choice cannot see you within 28 days.
- you require further oral health treatment.

You should be aware that failure to attend your appointment may result in a charge from the [private dentist](#) and a review of your eligibility for this Scheme.

The Area Health Service will not accept liability for payment of additional unauthorised treatment.
