Figure 89. Trauma admissions to Royal North Shore Hospital by age and gender

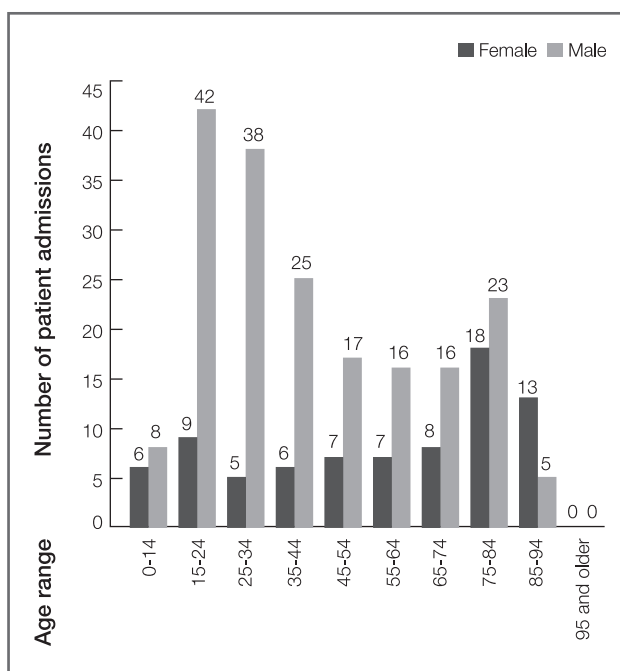

Figure 90. Trauma admissions to Royal Prince Alfred Hospital by age and gender

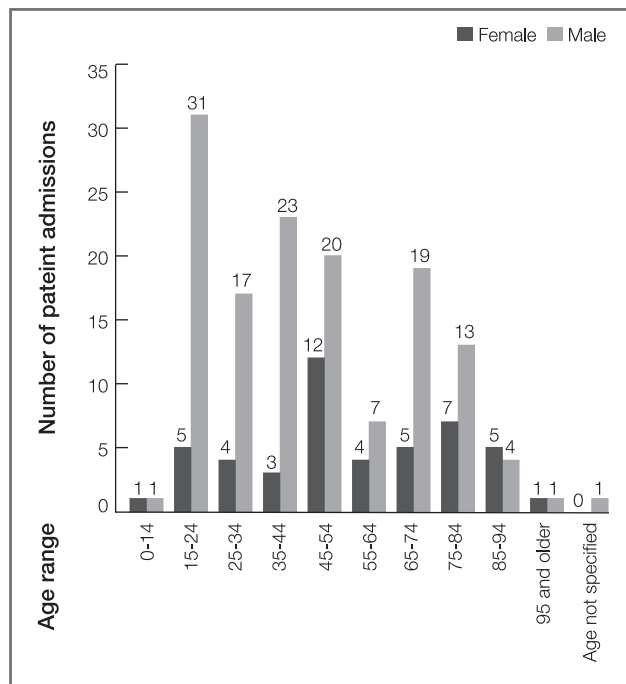

Figure 91. Trauma admissions to St George Hospital by age and gender

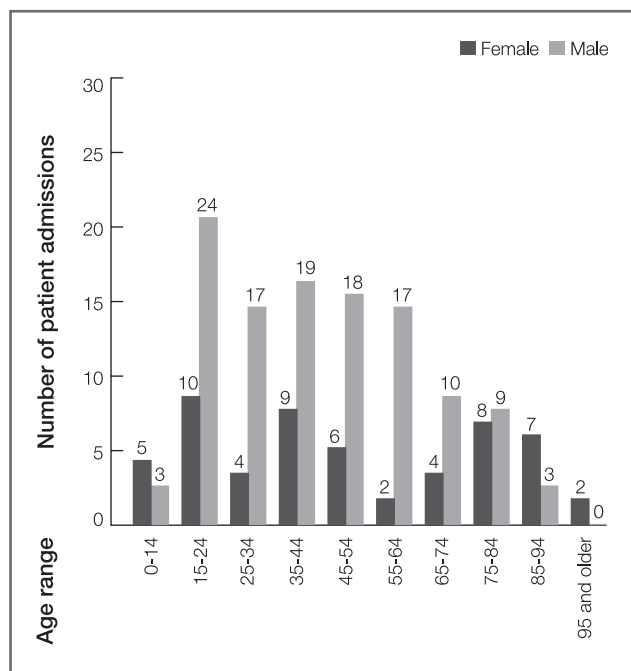

Figure 92. Trauma admissions to St Vincent's Hospital by age and gender

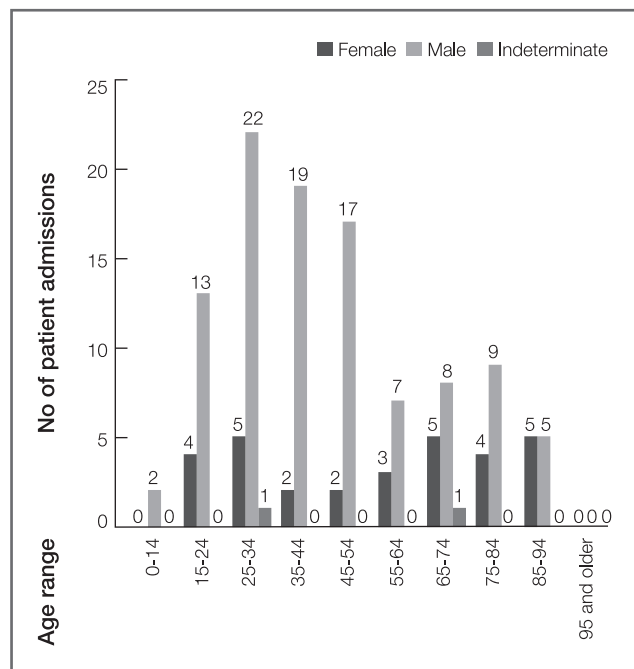

Figure 93. Trauma admissions to Sydney Children's Hospital by age and gender

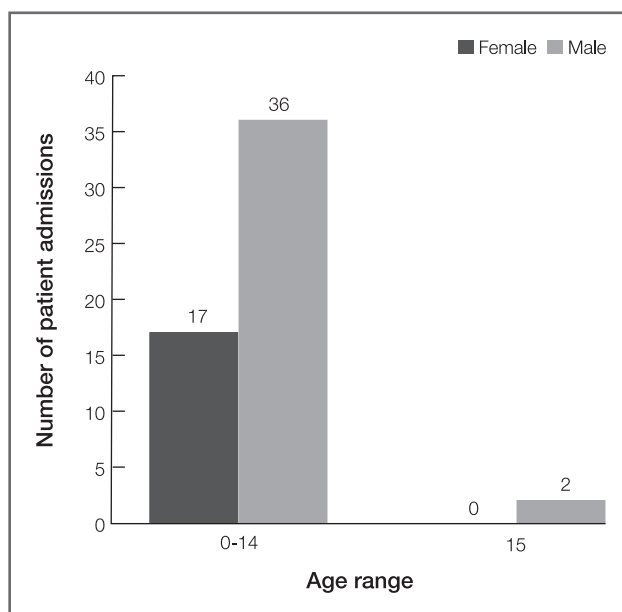


Figure 94. Paediatric trauma admissions to Sydney Children's Hospital by age and gender

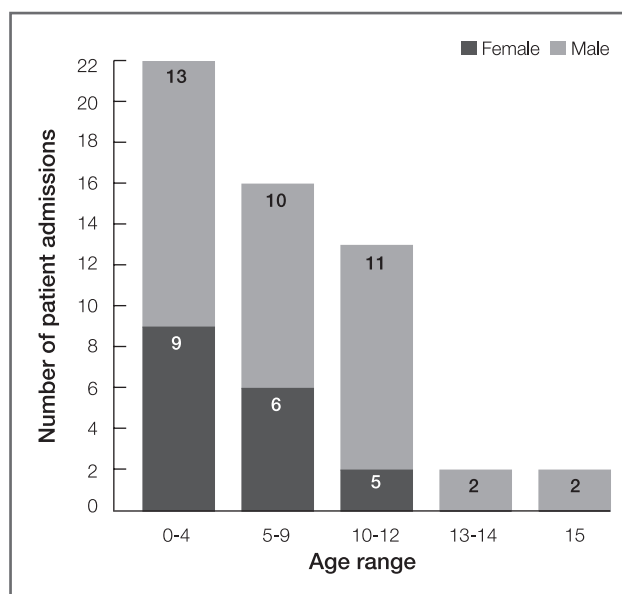

Figure 95. Trauma admissions to The Children’s Hospital at Westmead by age and gender

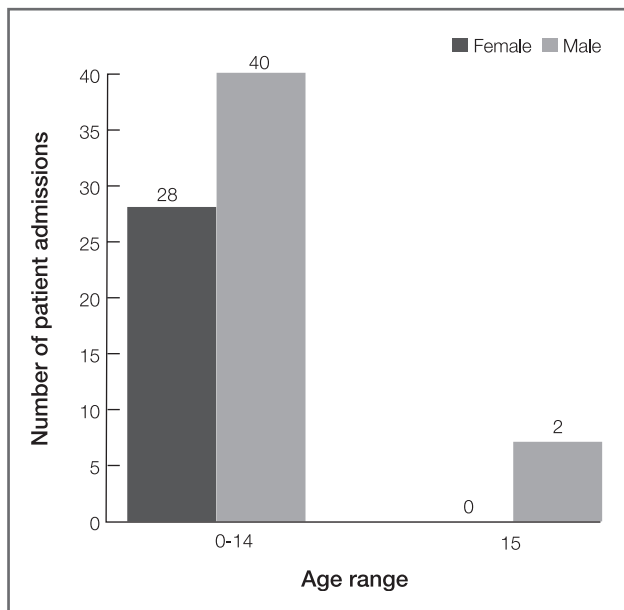


Figure 96. Paediatric trauma admissions to The Children’s Hospital at Westmead by age and gender

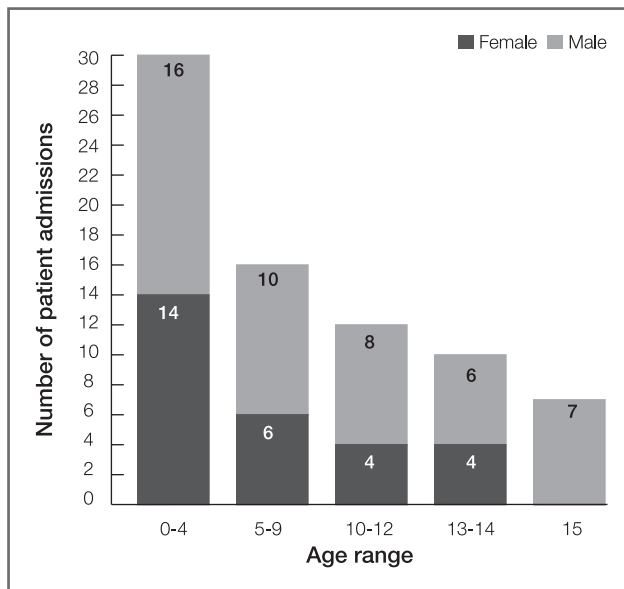

Figure 97. Trauma admissions to Westmead Hospital by age and gender

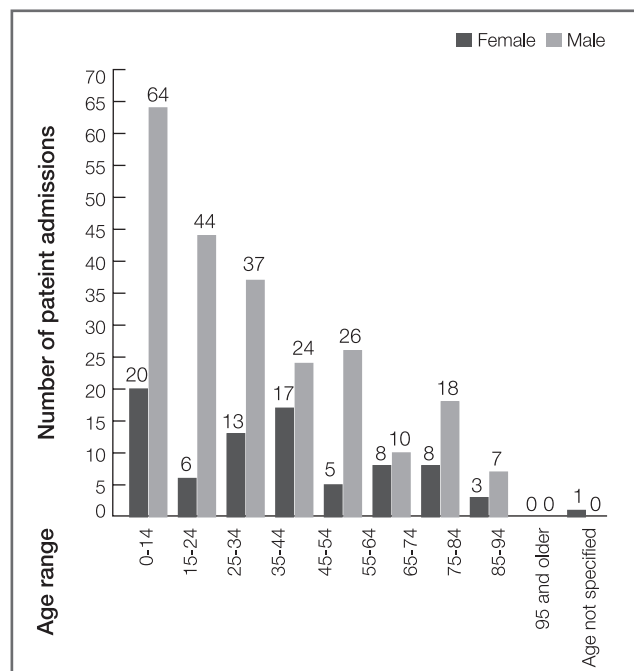
