

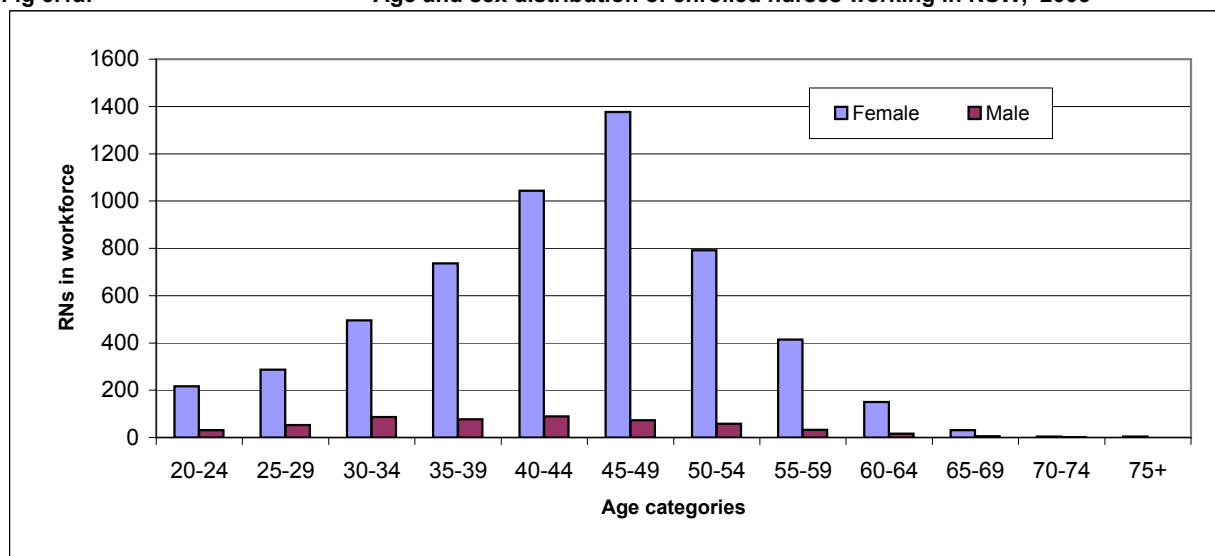

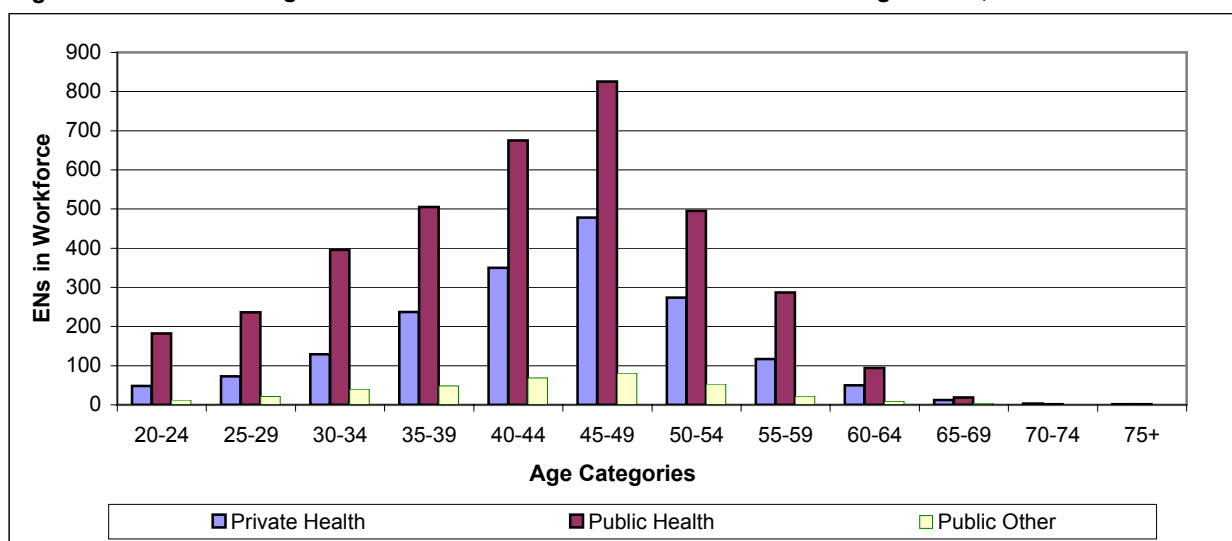
**Fig 5.1a:** Age and sex distribution of enrolled nurses working in NSW, 2005

Fig. 6.1 Percentage age distribution, registered nurses working in NSW, 2001 – 2005

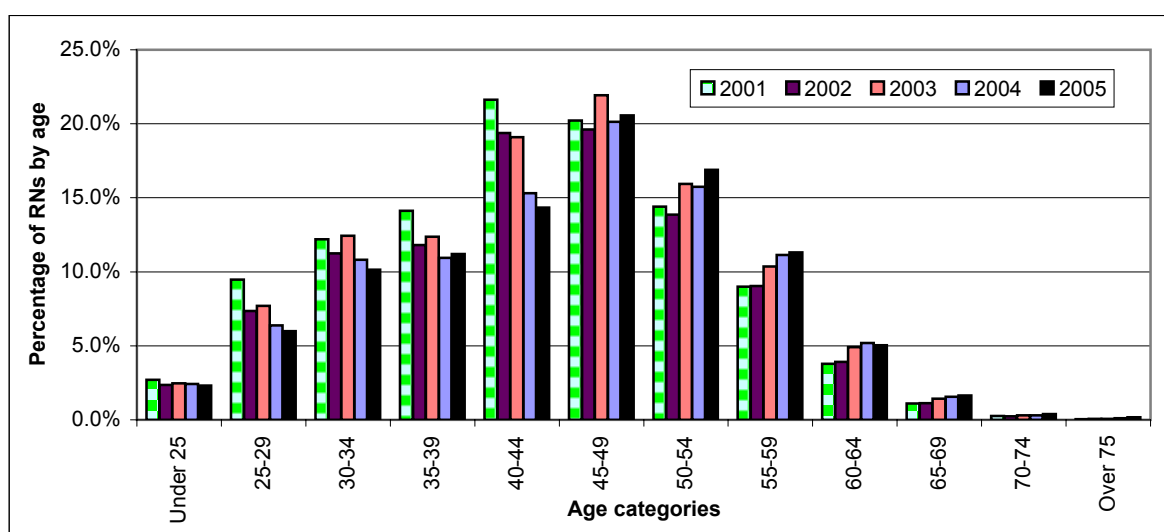

Fig. 7.1: Percentage age distribution, enrolled nurses working in NSW, 2001 – 2005

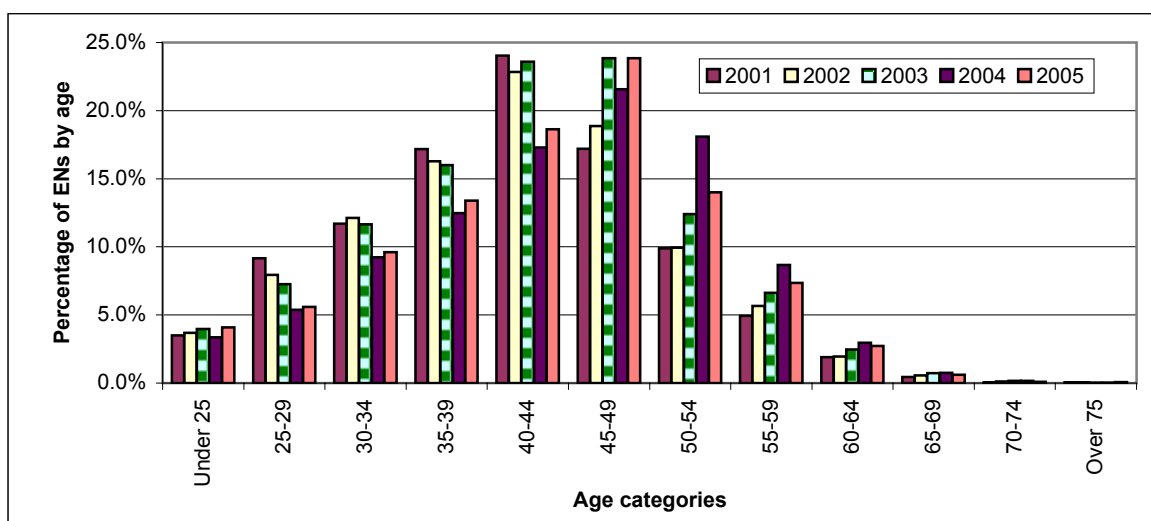
