(WITH NEW SOUTH WALES VARIATIONS)

SCHEDULE 1

Each entry appearing in Schedule 1 of Part 4 of the current Poisons Standard (known as the “*Standard for the Uniform Scheduling of Drugs and Poisons*”) prepared for the purposes of the Therapeutic Goods Act 1989 of the Commonwealth.

EXEMPTIONS:

Any substance listed in this Schedule is exempted from the operation of this Schedule when contained in any product listed or described in Appendix A of Part 5 of the current Poisons Standard.

SCHEDULE 2

Each entry appearing in Schedule 2 of Part 4 of the current Poisons Standard (known as the “*Standard for the Uniform Scheduling of Drugs and Poisons*”) prepared for the purposes of the Therapeutic Goods Act 1989 of the Commonwealth, with the exception of the entries relating to:

CODEINE

In addition the following entries are included in this Schedule:

CODEINE when:

- (a) compounded:
 - (i) with a single non-opiate analgesic substance:
 - (A) in tablets or capsules packed in blister or strip packaging or in a container with a child resistant closure; or
 - (B) in individually wrapped powders, each containing 10 mg or less of codeine; or
 - (ii) with one or more therapeutically active substances other than a non-opiate analgesic substance:
 - (A) in divided preparations each containing 10 mg or less of codeine; or
 - (B) in undivided preparations containing 0.25 per cent or less of codeine;

and

- (b) labelled with a recommended daily dose not exceeding 60 mg of codeine.

EXEMPTIONS:

Any substance listed in this Schedule is exempted from the operation of this Schedule when contained in any product listed or described in Appendix A of Part 5 of the current Poisons Standard.

SCHEDULE 3

Each entry appearing in Schedule 3 of Part 4 of the current Poisons Standard (known as the “*Standard for the Uniform Scheduling of Drugs and Poisons*”) prepared for the purposes of the Therapeutic Goods Act 1989 of the Commonwealth, with the exception of the entry relating to:

CODEINE

In addition the following entries are included in this Schedule:

CODEINE when compounded with paracetamol in divided preparations containing 12 mg or less of codeine per dosage unit with a recommended daily dose greater than 60 mg but not exceeding 100 mg of codeine when:

- (a) packed in blister or strip packaging or in a container with a child-resistant closure; and
- (b) in a primary pack containing 12 or less dosage units.

EXEMPTIONS:

Any substance listed in this Schedule is exempted from the operation of this Schedule when contained in any product listed or described in Appendix A of Part 5 of the current Poisons Standard.

SCHEDULE 4

Each entry appearing in Schedule 4 of Part 4 of the current Poisons Standard (known as the "*Standard for the Uniform Scheduling of Drugs and Poisons*") prepared for the purposes of the Therapeutic Goods Act 1989 of the Commonwealth.

EXEMPTIONS:

Any substance listed in this Schedule is exempted from the operation of this Schedule when contained in any product listed or described in Appendix A of Part 5 of the current Poisons Standard.

SCHEDULE 5

Each entry appearing in Schedule 5 of Part 4 of the current Poisons Standard (known as the “*Standard for the Uniform Scheduling of Drugs and Poisons*”) prepared for the purposes of the Therapeutic Goods Act 1989 of the Commonwealth.

EXEMPTIONS:

Any substance listed in this Schedule is exempted from the operation of this Schedule when contained in any product listed or described in Appendix A of Part 5 of the current Poisons Standard.

SCHEDULE 6

Each entry appearing in Schedule 6 of Part 4 of the current Poisons Standard (known as the "*Standard for the Uniform Scheduling of Drugs and Poisons*") prepared for the purposes of the Therapeutic Goods Act 1989 of the Commonwealth.

EXEMPTIONS:

Any substance listed in this Schedule is exempted from the operation of this Schedule when contained in any product listed or described in Appendix A of Part 5 of the current Poisons Standard.

SCHEDULE 7

Each entry appearing in Schedule 7 of Part 4 and Appendix C of Part 5 of the current Poisons Standard (known as the “*Standard for the Uniform Scheduling of Drugs and Poisons*”) prepared for the purposes of the Therapeutic Goods Act 1989 of the Commonwealth.

EXEMPTIONS:

Any substance listed in this Schedule is exempted from the operation of this Schedule when contained in any product listed or described in Appendix A of Part 5 of the current Poisons Standard.

SCHEDULE 8

Each entry appearing in Schedule 8 of Part 4 of the current Poisons Standard (known as the “*Standard for the Uniform Scheduling of Drugs and Poisons*”) prepared for the purposes of the Therapeutic Goods Act 1989 of the Commonwealth.

In addition the following entries are included in this Schedule:

ETORPHINE

TETRAHYDROCANNABINOL and its alkyl homologues except:

- (a) when separately specified in this Schedule;
- (b) in hemp seed oil, containing 50 mg/kg or less of tetrahydrocannabinols, when labelled “Not for internal use” or “Not to be taken”; or
- (c) in products for purposes other than internal human use containing 50 mg/kg or less of tetrahydrocannabinols.

EXEMPTIONS:

Any substance listed in this Schedule (other than any hallucinogen as defined in clause 3 of the Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008) is exempted from the operation of this Schedule when contained in any product listed or described in Appendix A of Part 5 of the current Poisons Standard.
