

# NSW Quarantine Worker Surveillance and Testing Program (the NSW Testing Program)

## **Designated Workers**

The *Public Health (COVID-19 Air Transportation Quarantine) Order (No 2) 2021* (Order) prohibits designated quarantine facility workers, designated transportation providers and designated airport workers from providing certain services or entering certain premises unless they are testing for COVID-19 in accordance with this document the NSW Testing Program (this document).

A designated quarantine facility worker is a person who is permitted to enter a quarantine facility and who, in the course of the person's employment, exercises functions or provides services in relation to the quarantine facility, and who is specified in the NSW Testing Program.

A designated transportation provider is a person who, in the course of the person's employment, provides a transportation service to a relevant person, and who is specified in the NSW Testing Program.

A designated airport worker is a person who, in the course of the person's employment, exercises functions or provides services at an airport and who is specified in the NSW Testing Program.

The employer of a designated quarantine facility worker, designated transportation provider and designated airport worker must ensure that the worker complies with these requirements.

On and from 1 November 2021, NSW Testing Program is set out below.
