### Important information

- Information in this declaration will determine whether you are permitted to go into self-isolation or are required to go to a quarantine facility.
- This declaration must be completed by flight crew members arriving from overseas on each occasion of arriving in NSW from overseas and prior to leaving the airport. If you fail to provide the information in this declaration, you will be directed to a quarantine facility.
- Flight crew members must ensure the information provided in this declaration is true and accurate. Failure to do so without reasonable excuse is an offence carrying a maximum penalty of \$11,000 and/or 6 months imprisonment. An on-the-spot fine of \$1,000 can also be issued in other cases.
- If you are permitted to leave NSW without going into quarantine, you will have to follow the public health requirements that apply in your State or Territory. This could be either a requirement to self-isolate or a requirement to go into quarantine.

\* **Suitable transport** means an aeroplane with no passengers other than other interstate crew members or in the case of travelling to ACT residents, in a private vehicle.
