

**NOTICE**  
**DECLARATION OF HIGH COVID-19 RISK PREMISES**

*Public Health (COVID-19 Self-Isolation) Order (No 3) 2021*

I, Dr Marianne Gale, Deputy Chief Health Officer, acting as delegate of the Minister for Health and Medical Research under section 21 of the Health Administration Act 1982, and pursuant to clause 9 of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Self-Isolation) Order (No 3) 2021* ("the Order")

**HEREBY DECLARE**

69 Park Avenue, Kingswood 2747 ("the Premises") to be a high COVID-19 risk premises in accordance with the Order, that should be closed due to a risk of transmission of COVID-19 between residents of the Premises.

In making this Declaration I have had regard to the following:

- (i) The Premises contains 32 separate dwellings;
- (ii) Several of the dwellings in the Premises are "COVID-19 risk premises" as:
  - a. At least 3 residents living in 3 different dwellings within the Premises have received a diagnosis of COVID-19, and are therefore subject to clause 6 of the Order; and
  - b. At least 9 residents living in at least 5 different dwellings within the Premises, are close contacts and therefore subject to clause 7 of the Order;
- (iii) Advice provided by a public health officer appointed under section 121 of the Public Health Act, that there is a risk of transmission of COVID-19 between residents of the Premises

This Declaration commences on publication on the website of NSW Health on 11 September 2021, and is in effect until the end of 25 September 2021, being 14 days from the date of publication of the Notice of Declaration.

The terms used in this Notice have the same meaning as under the Order and the Public Health Act 2010.
