



Exemption

Public Health (COVID-19 Maritime Quarantine) Order (No 3) 2021

Made under the *Public Health Act 2010 (NSW)*

I, **Dr Kerry Chant**, delegate of the Minister for Health and Medical Research, under clause 18 of the Public Health (COVID-19 Maritime Quarantine) Order (No 3) 2021, hereby grant the following exemption to that Order:

- 1) An Exempt Person is exempt from Clause 8 of the Order.

In this exemption

- An Exempt Person means a person entering NSW on an Exempt Vessel
- An Exempt Vessel means a vessel used by or on behalf of the Australian Defence Force:
 - 1) That has not stopped at a port outside of Australia in the last 14 full days prior to arriving in Australia, and
 - 2) That has had no person board the vessel in the 14 days prior to arriving in Australia, and
 - 3) Where the name of each passenger and crew on board the vessel and the planned place of entry in NSW has been sent to MOH-COVID19-Quarantine@health.nsw.gov.au at least 72 hours before disembarkation
 - 4) Where all passengers and crew aboard the vessel have been tested for COVID-19 and have received a negative result before arriving in Australia but only if the tests occurred at least 12 days after the vessel last stopped at an international port.
 - 5) Where the results of the test results above are provided to MOH-COVID19-Quarantine@health.nsw.gov.au

This exemption may be revoked at any time.
