



**Exemption under *Public Health (COVID-19 Additional Restrictions for Delta Outbreak) Order (No 2) 2021* under the *Public Health Act 2010 (NSW)***

I, Brad Hazzard MP, Minister for Health and Medical Research, under clause 7.2 of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Additional Restrictions for Delta Outbreak) Order (No 2) 2021* (Order) grant the following exemptions to the Order:

- 1) Despite clause 3.2 of the Order, an Exempt Person (Stay at Home Area) can leave their place of residence on 16 September 2021 for the purpose of the engaging in prayer and reflection on Yom Kippur subject to the following conditions:
  - a. An Exempt Person (Stay at Home Area) must not gather in a group of more than 5 persons (not including children 12 years and under);
  - b. Each Exempt Person (Stay at Home Area) must remain in the Local Government Area in which they reside or within 5 kilometres from their residence AND within an Exempt Area; and
  - c. An Exempt Person (Stay at Home Area) who is at least 16 years old must carry their vaccination evidence and produce it on request of a police officer.
- 2) Despite clause 4.2 Order, an Exempt Person (Area of Concern) can leave their place of residence on 16 September 2021 for the purpose of engaging in prayer and reflection on Yom Kippur subject to the following conditions:
  - a. An Exempt Person (Area of Concern) must remain in a group consisting of only members of their own household;
  - b. Each Exempt Person (Area of Concern) must remain within 5 kilometres from their residence AND within an Exempt Area;
  - c. Each Exempt Person (Area of Concern) is only away from their place of residence for no more than 2 hours for the purpose of engaging in prayer and reflection; and
  - d. An Exempt Person (Area of Concern) who is at least 16 years old must carry their vaccination evidence and produce it on request of a police officer.

In this exemption:

A handwritten signature in blue ink, appearing to be "Brad Hazzard", written over the text "In this exemption:".

- an area of concern and a stay at home area have the same meaning as the Order;
- an Exempt Area is an area nominated by the Chief Executive Officer of the NSW Jewish Board of Deputies;
- Exempt Person (Area of Concern) means a person who usually resides in an area of concern and, if 16 years or older, is fully vaccinated;
- an Exempt Person (Stay at Home Area) means a person who usually resides in a stay at home area and, if 16 years or older, is fully vaccinated;
- Fully vaccinated has the same meaning as the Order.

**Note: all other obligations of the Order continue to apply.**
