



Exemption

Public Health (COVID-19 Interstate Travellers) Order (No 3) 2021

Made under the *Public Health Act 2010 (NSW)*

I, Michael Douglas, delegate of the Minister for Health and Medical Research, under clause 23 of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Interstate Travellers) Order (No 3) 2021 (the Order)*, hereby grant the following exemption from that Order:

1. Despite clauses 6(4) and 6(5) of the Order, an Exempt Person is only required to complete a further traveller self-declaration form in relation to the affected area of the Australian Capital Territory once every 72 hours.

In this exemption:

- *Exempt Person* means an *affected person* who is required to complete a traveller self-declaration form upon entering NSW because the person has been in the Australian Capital Territory in the previous 14 days
- An *affected person* has the same meaning as under the Order.
