



Exemption under the *Public Health (COVID-19 Additional Restrictions for Delta Outbreak) Order (No 2) 2021* [NSW] under the *Public Health Act 2010* (NSW)

I, Michelle Cretikos, delegate of the Minister for Health and Medical Research, under clause 7.2 of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Additional Restrictions for Delta Outbreak) Order (No 2) 2021* [NSW] (Order), hereby:

- 1) Grant an Exempt Person an exemption from the requirement to obtain a permit under:
 - a. clause 4.3(2) of the Order
 - b. clause 4.3A of the Order; and
 - c. clause 5.4(2) of the Order, but limited to when a permit is required for the purposes of clause 5.4(1)(b) of the Order.
- 2) The exemption at clause (1) of this instrument is subject to the conditions below:
 - a. For a person listed in (a), (c), (d), or (e) of the definition of *Exempt Person*, the Exempt Person must provide details of the workplace(s) the person will be working and their employer(s) on request of a police officer.
 - b. For a person listed in (b) of the definition of *Exempt Person*, the Exempt Person must provide a letter or other document from the Australian Defence Force (ADF) indicating that the person is providing services to the ADF on request of a police officer.

In this exemption:

- *Greater Sydney* has the same meaning as in the Order
- An *Exempt Person* means:
 - a. Australian Defence Force personnel
 - b. A person engaged by the ADF to undertake work on ADF infrastructure and vessels
 - c. A person providing the following health services:
 - i. Aeromedical retrieval
 - ii. A patient transport service
 - iii. Organ and tissue transport and retrieval
 - d. A registered health practitioner who is undertaking work because of an emergency
 - e. A registered health practitioner who is undertaking work because of unforeseen or unplanned circumstances or who provides health services at a public health facility or private health facility or health practice as a locum or as part of an agency service

Note: as a result of this exemption, an Exempt Person is not required to obtain a permit before the Exempt Person

- who is an authorised worker, leaves an area of concern for work,
- enters an area of concern for work, or
- travels more than 50 kilometres from Greater Sydney to carry out work
