



## Exemption

### Public Health (COVID-19 Air Transportation Quarantine) Order (No 4) 2021

Made under the *Public Health Act 2010* (NSW)

I, Dr Kerry Chant, Chief Health Officer and delegate Minister for Health and Medical Research, under clause 32 of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Air Transportation Quarantine) Order (No 4) 2021 (the Order)* hereby:

- 1) From 28 November 2021 revoke the exemption made by the Minister for Health and Medical Research on 31 October 2021 at 9.42pm and attached to this instrument, and
- 2) From 28 November 2021 exempt an Exempt Person from clauses 8 and 10 of the Order subject to the following conditions:
  - a. The Exempt Person must seek PCR testing for COVID-19:
    - i. 24 hours after arriving in NSW, and
    - ii. 5 or 6 days after arriving in NSW, and
    - iii. if the Exempt Person develops any symptoms of COVID-19.
  - b. For 14 days after arriving in NSW, the Exempt Person must comply with the NSW Health Guidelines for Recent Fully Vaccinated Arrivals.

**The Exempt Person must continue to comply with Part 3A of the Order, including in relation to any requirement to self-isolate.**

In this instrument:

- A country of concern has the same meaning as the Order
- COVID-19 vaccine has the same meaning as the Order.
- Exempt Person means a person, other than a relevant flight crew member, who has not been in a country of concern in the previous 14 days:
  - a. a person who is not a fully vaccinated arrival because the person has a medical contraindication to a COVID-19 vaccine and has a certificate or other documentation from an Australian or overseas medical practitioner that indicates that the person has a medical contraindication to a COVID-19 vaccine, and
  - b. a person aged under 12 years who is not a fully vaccinated arrival, but only if the person is accompanied by a person mentioned in paragraph (a) who is aged 18 years or more.
- Fully vaccinated arrival has the same meaning as the Order.

This instrument may be revoked at any time.

**Note: If the Exempt Person travels to another jurisdiction within 14 days after arriving in Australia, they may be subject to restrictions or quarantine in the other jurisdiction.**

**Exemption under the  
*Public Health (COVID-19 Air Transportation  
Quarantine) Order (No 3)*  
under the *Public Health Act 2010 (NSW)***

I, Brad Hazzard MP, Minister for Health and Medical Research, under clause 33 of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Air Transportation Quarantine) Order (No 3) 2021 (the Order)*, hereby exempt an Exempt Person from clauses 7 and 11 of the Order subject to the following conditions:

- 1) The Exempt Person must seek PCR testing for COVID-19:
  - a. 24 hours after arriving in NSW, and
  - b. 5 or 6 days after arriving in NSW, and
  - c. if the Exempt Person develops any symptoms of COVID-19.
- 2) For 14 days after arriving in NSW, the Exempt Person must comply with the NSW Health Guidelines for Recent Fully Vaccinated Arrivals.


In this instrument:

- COVID-19 vaccine has the same meaning as the Order.
- Exempt Person means:
  - a. a person who is not a fully vaccinated arrival because the person has a medical contraindication to a COVID-19 vaccine and has a certificate or other documentation from an Australian or overseas medical practitioner that indicates that the person has a medical contraindication to a COVID-19 vaccine, and
  - b. a person aged under 12 years who is not a fully vaccinated arrival, but only if the person is accompanied by a person mentioned in paragraph (a) who is aged 18 years or more.
- Fully vaccinated arrival has the same meaning as the Order.

This instrument:

- commences at the beginning of 1 November 2021;
- and
- may be revoked at any time.

**Note: If the Exempt Person travels to another jurisdiction within 14 days after arriving in Australia, they may be subject to restrictions or quarantine in the other jurisdiction.**
