



Exemption

Public Health (COVID-19 Interstate Travellers) Order (No 3) 2021

Made under the *Public Health Act 2010 (NSW)*

I, Kerry Chant, Chief Health Officer and delegate of the Minister for Health and Medical Research, under clause 23 of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Interstate Travellers) Order (No 3) 2021 (the Order)*, hereby:

1. Grant an Exempt Person an exemption from clauses 6(3) and (4), 7(1), and 8 of the Order subject to the following condition:
 - a. The Exempt Person is only exempt when entering NSW in an emergency situation or in unforeseen or unplanned circumstances for the purposes of their work as an Emergency Worker.

In this exemption:

- *Exempt Person* means an *affected person* who:
 - is required to enter New South Wales in an emergency situation or in unforeseen or unplanned circumstances as part of their role as an *Emergency Worker*; AND
 - completes a traveller self-declaration within 72 hours of entering New South Wales.
- *Emergency Worker* means a person who:
 - works for an emergency services organisation within the meaning of the *State Emergency and Rescue Management Act 1989* and includes a police officer, a member of the Ambulance Service of NSW, and a member of Fire and Rescue NSW (or an equivalent emergency services organisation in another Australian State or Territory).
- An *affected person* has the same meaning as under the Order.
