



## Exemption Public Health (COVID-19 Air and Maritime) Order (No 1) 2022

Made under the *Public Health Act 2010 (NSW)*

I, Brad Hazzard, Minister for Health, under clause 43 of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Air and Maritime) Order (No 1) 2022 (the Order)*, do hereby exempt an Exempt Person from clauses 12 and 13 of the Order, subject to the following conditions:

1. The Exempt Person must undergo a rapid antigen test for COVID-19 as soon as practicable, but no later than 24 hours after the Exempt Person's arrival unless the NSW Health Guidelines provide that the person is not required to undergo a test for COVID-19.
2. The Exempt Person must travel by the most practicable direct route to the person's residence or a place suitable to reside in, and self-isolate until the Exempt Person undergoes a rapid antigen test for COVID-19, and the result for the test is negative.
3. The Exempt Person must comply with the NSW Health Guideline for All International Arrivals for 14 days after the person arrives, including in relation to tests for COVID-19 and restrictions or limitations about attending premises.

### In this Exemption:

'Exempt Person' means a person who is a relevant air arrival who is not a fully vaccinated arrival and who arrives in New South Wales on or after 6pm on 29 April 2022.

Terms used in this exemption have the same meaning as the Order.

**This exemption instrument can be revoked at any time.**
