



Exemption

Public Health (COVID-19 Self-Isolation) Order (No 4) 2021

Made under the *Public Health Act 2010 (NSW)*

I, Dr Kerry Chant, Chief health Officer and delegate of Minister for Health, being satisfied that it is necessary to protect the health and well-being of any member of the public, under clause 15 of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Self Isolation) Order (No 4) 2021*, hereby grant the following exemption from the Order:

1. An Exempt Person is exempt from clauses 7A and 8 of the Order but only in relation to attending work for the Employer subject to the following conditions:
 - a) The Exempt Person must only attend work if approved by their Employer or person authorised by their Employer,
 - b) The Exempt Person must travel directly to and from the place they are residing and the place they are working,
 - c) The Exempt Person must wear a mask at all times while working, unless eating or drinking or the mask needs to be removed to provide services,
 - d) The Exempt Person must comply with any risk mitigation strategies put in place by their Employer, and
 - e) If the Exempt Person has any symptoms of COVID-19 they must immediately seek a PCR test for COVID-19 and not attend work until they receive a negative result.

In this instrument:

- 1) An Employer means the Health Administration Corporation.
- 2) An Exempt Person means a close contact of a diagnosed COVID-19 case who works for the Employer and whose absence from the workplace has been identified by the Employer (or person authorised by the Employer) as a critical risk to safe service delivery to patients and who has been identified by the Employer (or person authorised by the Employer) as being unable to work from home.

This exemption instrument may be revoked at any time.

Exemption

Public Health (COVID-19 Self-Isolation) Order (No 4) 2021

Made under the *Public Health Act 2010 (NSW)*

I, Brad Hazzard, Minister for Health, being satisfied that it is necessary to protect the health and well-being of any member of the public, under clause 15 of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Self Isolation) Order (No 4) 2021*, hereby grant the following exemption from Order:

1. An Exempt Person is exempt from clauses 7A and 8 of the Order but only in relation to attending an Exempt Workplace for work subject to the following conditions:
 - a) The Exempt Person must only attend the Exempt Workplace for work if approved by their Employer,
 - b) The Exempt Person must travel directly to and from the place they are residing and the Exempt Workplace,
 - c) The Exempt Person must wear a mask at all times in the Exempt Workplace while at the Exempt Workplace, unless eating or drinking or the mask needs to be removed to provide services,
 - d) The Exempt Person must comply with any risk mitigation strategies put in place by their Employer, and
 - e) If the Exempt Person has any symptoms of COVID-19 they must immediately seek a PCR test for COVID-19 and not attend the Workplace until they receive a negative result.

In this instrument:

- 1) An Employer means a public health organisation or a private health facility.
- 2) An Exempt Person means a close contact of a diagnosed COVID-19 case who works for an Employer at an Exempt Workplace and whose absence from the workplace has been identified by the Employer (or person authorised by the Employer) as a critical risk to safe service delivery to patients and who has been identified by the Employer (or person authorised by the Employer) as being unable to work from home.
- 3) An Exempt Workplace is the workplace identified by an Employer (or person authorised by the Employer) as to where an Exempt Person is to provide services.

This exemption instrument may be revoked at any time.
