



Exemption under the *Public Health (COVID-19 Additional Restrictions for Delta Outbreak) Order (No 2) 2021* under the *Public Health Act 2010 (NSW)*

I, Brad Hazzard MP, Minister for Health and Medical Research, under clause 7.2 of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Additional Restrictions for Delta Outbreak) Order (No 2) 2021* [NSW] (Order) and section 43 of the *Interpretation Act 1987*, hereby

1. Revoke the exemption made by me on 10 September 2021 and annexed to this instrument; and
2. Grant the following exemption:

Despite clauses 3.2 and 4.2 of the Order, an Exempt Person can be away from their residence to undertake a driving lesson or driving supervision of another Exempt Person subject to the following conditions:

 - a. There are no other persons in the vehicle other than one other Exempt Person from the same residence or a child 12 years and under, and
 - b. The Exempt Person must:
 - i. carry evidence showing the person's name and place of residence, and
 - ii. produce the evidence for inspection if requested to do so by a police officer.

In this exemption:

- An Exempt Person means a person who is:
 - a learner driver; or
 - a person from the same residence as the learner driver who is supervising the learner driver.

Note: as a result of this exemption:

- **A person who lives in a stay at home area or area of concern may leave their residence to undertake a driving lesson with another person from their residence.**

Exemption under the *Public Health (COVID-19 Additional Restrictions for Delta Outbreak) Order (No 2) 2021* under the *Public Health Act 2010 (NSW)*

I, Brad Hazzard MP, Minister for Health and Medical Research, under clause 7.2 of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Additional Restrictions for Delta Outbreak) Order (No 2) 2021* [NSW] (Order), hereby grant the following exemption:

- 1) Despite clauses 3.2 and 4.2 of the Order, an Exempt Person can be away from their residence to undertake a driving lesson or driving supervision of another Exempt Person subject to the following conditions:
 - a. There are no other persons in the vehicle other than one other Exempt Person from the same residence or a child 12 years and under, and
 - b. The Exempt Person must:
 - i. carry evidence showing the person's name and place of residence, and
 - ii. produce the evidence for inspection if requested to do so by a police officer.
 - c. If the Exempt Person resides in an area of concern, this exemption does not operate between the hours of 9pm on a day and 5am on the following day.

In this exemption:

- An Exempt Person means a person who is:
 - a learner driver; or
 - a person from the same residence as the learner driver who is supervising the learner driver.

Note: as a result of this exemption:

- A person who lives in a stay at home area or area of concern may leave their residence to undertake a driving lesson with another person from their residence. However, if the person lives in an area of concern, the exemption only enables a driving lesson outside of the hours of 9pm and 5am on the following day.
