

Exemption under Public Health (COVID-19 General) Order 2021 under the Public Health Act 2010 (NSW)

I, Brad Hazzard MP, Minister for Health and Medical Research, under clause 7.1 of the *Public Health (COVID-19 General) Order 2021* (**the Order**) hereby grant the following exemption:

- 1) A fully vaccinated person is exempt from clause 6.5A and clause 6.6(2) of the Order to the extent they are travelling to Lord Howe Island, and subject to the condition below:
 - a) The fully vaccinated person must take the most practicable direct route to Lord Howe Island.

In this exemption:

Fully vaccinated person has the same meaning as the Order.

Note: all other requirements of the Order must be complied with, including vaccination obligations attaching to adults seeking to take a holiday or undertake recreation outside the local government area in which the adult resides.

The effect of this exemption is that a fully vaccinated person can leave Greater Sydney for the purpose of travelling to Lord Howe Island (including to take a holiday or undertake recreation at Lord Howe Island).
