



**Exemption under the *Public Health (COVID-19 Additional Restrictions for Delta Outbreak) Order (No 2) 2021* under the *Public Health Act 2010 (NSW)***

I, Brad Hazzard MP, Minister for Health and Medical Research, under clause 7.2 of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Additional Restrictions for Delta Outbreak) Order (No 2) 2021* [NSW] ('Order'), hereby grant the following exemption:

- 1) Despite clauses 3.2 and 4.2 of the Order, an Exempt Person can be away from their residence to travel to a marina or mooring where their vessel is moored to undertake work on their vessel to ensure that the vessel is maintained in a sea worthy condition, including being able to undertake a voyage under its own power or sail, subject to the conditions below:
  - a. The Exempt Person must travel to and from the marina or mooring where their vessel is moored by the most practical direct route,
  - b. The Exempt Person must take reasonably practicable steps to remain 1.5 metres from any other person while at the marina or mooring, and
  - c. The Exempt Person must wear a mask while at the marina or mooring.

In this exemption:

- An Exempt Person means a person who is the owner or occupier of a maritime vessel.
