



Exemption under *Public Health (COVID-19 General) Order 2021* under the *Public Health Act 2010 (NSW)*

I, Dr Kerry Chant, Chief Health Officer and delegate of the Minister for Health and Medical Research, under clause 7.1 of the *Public Health (COVID-19 General) Order 2021 (Order)* hereby grant the following exemptions:

1. A person is exempt from clause 2.18(2) of the Order if they are attending an Exempt Premises to obtain a health service from a registered health practitioner, or to accompany a person who is obtaining a health service from the Exempt Premises.
2. The occupier of an Exempt Premises is exempt from clauses 2.18(1) and (3) of the Order but only in respect of allowing a person under clause 1) of this instrument to enter the Exempt Premises.

In this exemption:

- Exempt Premises are premises where a registered health practitioner usually provides health services
- Health service includes purchasing health supplies, devices, or equipment
- Registered health practitioner has the same meaning as under the *Health Practitioner Regulation National Law (NSW)*

Note: all other obligations of the Order continue to apply.
