



Exemption under Public Health (COVID-19 Additional Restrictions for Delta Outbreak) Order (No 2) 2021 under the Public Health Act 2010 (NSW)

I, Brad Hazzard MP, Minister for Health and Medical Research, under clause 7.2 of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Additional Restrictions for Delta Outbreak) Order (No 2) 2021* (Order) grant the following exemption to the Order:

- 1) Despite clause 3.2 of the Order, on 7, 8, 15 and 16 of September 2021, an Exempt Person may leave their place of residence to blow the Shofar subject to the conditions below:
 - a. The Exempt Person can only blow the Shofar for a total maximum period for 3 hours over the course of each day this exemption applies,
 - b. At any one time, the Exempt Person can only blow the Shofar for a period of 10 minutes,
 - c. On each day the exemption applies, the Exempt Person can only blow the Shofar between the hours of 8 am and 5 pm, and
 - d. The Exempt Person can only blow the Shofar in an outdoor area in an Exempt Area.

In this exemption:

- an area of concern has the same meaning as the Order
- an Exempt Area is an area nominated by the Chief Executive Officer of the NSW Jewish Board of Deputies that is not in an area of concern
- an Exempt Person is a Rabbi or person nominated by the NSW Jewish Board of Deputies to blow the Shofar.
