



## Exemption

### Public Health (COVID-19 Air Transportation Quarantine) Order (No 2) 2021

Made under the *Public Health Act 2010 (NSW)*

I, Kerry Chant, Chief Health Officer and delegate of the Minister for Health and Medical Research, under clause 22 of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Air Transportation Quarantine) Order (No 2) 2021* (Order) hereby grant the following exemptions to that Order:

- 1) An Exempt Worker is exempt clause 20E(2) of the Order subject to the following conditions:
  - a. the Exempt Worker must receive their first COVID-19 vaccination dose on the confirmed date (being the vaccination date that was given to the Exempt Person by, or on behalf of, NSW Health or a medical practitioner), and
  - b. the Exempt Worker must, on request, provide their employer, a member of staff of NSW Health or a police officer with any records relating to the confirmed date and location of the first vaccination dose and confirmation that the nominated person has received their first dose of COVID-19 vaccination.
- 2) An employer of a nominated worker is exempt from clause 20E(4) of the Order but only in relation to an Exempt Worker.

In this exemption:

- An “Exempt Worker” means a nominated worker who:
  - has arranged to receive their first COVID-19 vaccination dose; AND
  - has been given a confirmed date by, or on behalf of, NSW Health or a medical practitioner to receive the vaccination; AND
  - the confirmed date of administration of that COVID-19 vaccination dose is prior to 6 July 2021.
- A “nominated worker” has the same meaning as the Order.

This exemption is revoked at the beginning of 6 July 2021.
