



Exemption under the *Public Health (COVID-19 Additional Restrictions for Delta Outbreak) Order 2021 [NSW]*

I, Brad Hazzard, Minister for Health and Medical Research, under clause 25 of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Additional Restrictions for Delta Outbreak) Order 2021* (Order), hereby grant an Exempt Person an exemption from clause 24E of the Order subject to the following conditions:

- 1) The Exempt Person is to take the most practicable direct route to and from their residence to the Workplace.
- 2) While in the Workplace, the Exempt Person must take reasonably practicable steps to minimise physical contact with any other person.
- 3) The Exempt Person must participate in any staff or visitor screening processes and comply with measures to mitigate the risk of COVID-19 put in place at the Workplace.
- 4) While at the Workplace, or travelling to the Workplace, the Exempt Person must provide documentation evidence showing that they have been vaccinated with two doses of the COVID-19 vaccine on request of a police officer or the person in charge of the Workplace or their delegate.
- 5) If the Exempt Person develops any symptoms of COVID-19, the Exempt Person must seek testing for COVID-19 and self-isolate while awaiting their results.

In this instrument:

- Exempt Person means:
 - a person who works for a relevant union **AND** who has been vaccinated with two doses of the COVID-19 vaccine.
- A relevant union means the Health Services Union, the NSW Nurses and Midwives Association, the Australian Paramedic Association and the Australian Salaried Medical Officers Federation of NSW
- The Workplace means a workplace where the employees the Exempt Person is representing works.

Note: an employer in Greater Sydney must require an employee to work from home unless it is not reasonably practicable for the employee to work from home.

An exempt person must comply with all other requirements in the Order.
