



Exemption

Public Health (COVID-19 Interstate Travellers) Order (No 2) 2021

Made under the *Public Health Act 2010 (NSW)*

I, Dr Kerry Chant, Chief Health Officer and delegate of the Minister for Health and Medical Research, under clause 24 of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Interstate Travellers) Order (No 2) 2021 (the Order)* hereby:

- 1) Grant the following exemptions to that Order:
 - a. A Border Region Resident is exempt from clauses 7 and 8(1) of the Order, but only if:
 - i. The Border Region Resident remains within the Border Region after entering NSW.
 - b. A NSW Border Region Resident is exempt from clause 11 of the Order, but only if:
 - i. The NSW Border Region Resident has not been to a place in Victoria that is outside the Border Region in the previous 14 days.

In this exemption:

- The “Border Region” means the same area shown as the border region on the Public Health (COVID-19 Border Control) Map (No 5) approved by the Minister for Health and Medical Research under the *Public Health (COVID-19 Border Control) Order (No 2) 2020* as in force on 22 November 2020 and dated 15 October 2020
- A “Border Region Resident” means a resident of NSW or Victoria who usually resides in the Border Region
