



Exemption under the Public Health (COVID-19 Restrictions on Gathering and Movement) Order (No 3) 2020

under the *Public Health Act 2010 (NSW)*

I, Brad Hazzard, the Minister for Health and Medical Research, under clause 14 of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Restrictions on Gathering and Movement) Order (No 3) 2020* hereby exempt the Operator or Occupier of a Ski Resort from the operation of clause 8(1)(a) of the Order subject to the conditions below:

- 1) The occupier of a Ski Resort must develop and comply with a COVID-19 safety plan.
- 2) The exemption only applies when the Ski Resort is being used for winter recreational activities including skiing and snowboarding.

In this exemption a Ski Resort means a ski related resort or ski or snow field in an alpine area.

Note: clause 8(1)(c) of the Order still applies and occupier must not allow persons to be on the premises (whether comprised of an outdoor or indoor space) if the size of the premises is insufficient to ensure there is 4 square metres of space for each person on the premises (unless otherwise exempted from this requirement under the Order).
