



Exemption under the Public Health (COVID-19 Restrictions on Gathering and Movement) Order (No 2) 2020
under the *Public Health Act 2010 (NSW)*

I, Brad Hazzard, the Minister for Health and Medical Research, under clause 12 of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Restrictions on Gathering and Movement) Order (No 2) 2020* hereby exempt indoor swimming pools with a length of 25 metres or greater from clause 7 of that Order subject to the conditions set out below:

- 1) The pool can only be open for the purpose of allowing squad training to take place.
- 2) Each lane of each swimming pool can only have one swimmer in the lane at any one time.
- 3) There are no more than 10 persons in a swimming pool at any one time.
- 4) In any designated area for parents, family or carers, this area can only be used if there is sufficient space to ensure there are 4 square metres of space of each person in the designated area.

The following persons are exempt from clause 6 of the Order if they are at the indoor public swimming pool in line with the exemption above:

- a) Staff members of the operator of the pool facility;
- b) Swimmers using the pool to participate in squad training;
- c) Trainers and coaches of the swimmers who are using the pool to participate in squad training; and
- d) Parents, family or carers of swimmers who are using the pool for the purpose of squad training.
