Information about COVID-19 testing clinics

社区的COVID-19检测覆盖率较低。

如出现症状，应接受检测，防止将COVID-19传染他人。

我应该接受检测吗？

- 如果您出现了相关症状，就应该接受检测。症状包括：发烧、咳嗽、喉咙疼/痒、呼吸急促、失去味觉或嗅觉。
- 即使您戴口罩且不太接触人，出现症状也需要接受检测。

检测过程安全吗？

- 检测机构干净安全。您可以放心接受检测。

检测需要花钱吗？我需要有Medicare医保卡才能接受检测吗？

- 如果是公立机构，检测是免费的。接受检测不需要Medicare医保卡。

哪些地方可以接受检测？

- 有很多机构可接受检测。点击下面网址查看新州的检测机构。

- 如果是公立机构，您可以直接前往，不需要预约。
- 有些检测机构您可以走进去。有些则需要坐在车里接受检测。
- 可提供口译服务。您到达之后，检测机构会安排电话口译员。
- 您也可以向GP（家庭医生）咨询检测事宜。GP会给您安排。

儿童可以接受检测吗？

- 儿童可以接受检测。
- 有些机构不对幼儿进行检测。您可以打电话到相关机构咨询，或在新州卫生部官网查阅检测的最低年龄限制：

检测需要花很长时间吗？

- 检测非常快。
- 如果诊所人多，您可能需要等一等。

我如何拿到结果？

- 大多数检测结果会通过短信通知，您也可以拨打检测机构的电话询问。一般情况下，24小时内就能出结果。
- 如果您的检测结果呈阳性，检测机构会给您打电话。

接受检测之后我应该做什么？

- 拿到结果之前应进行自我隔离，也就是必须待在家中，避免与他人接触。

如果我被检查出感染COVID-19，该怎么办？

- 我们会给您打电话，问您几个问题，然后告诉您应该怎么做。
- 您需要在家隔离14天，避免与他人接触。
- 大多数人不需要去医院或隔离酒店。
- 国家医疗系统会给予您支持。如需入院治疗，费用可全免。

Information about COVID-19 testing clinics

Not enough people in the community are getting tested for COVID-19.

Everyone with symptoms needs to get tested to help stop the community spread of COVID-19.

Should I get tested?

- If you have any symptoms you should get tested. Symptoms include fever, cough, sore/ scratchy throat, shortness of breath, loss of taste or smell.
- Even if you wear a mask and don't see many people, you should still get tested if you have symptoms.

Is it safe to get tested?

- The testing clinics are clean and safe. It is safe to get tested.

Do I have to pay to get tested? Do I need a Medicare card to get tested?

- In a public clinic, it is free to get tested. You don't need a Medicare card.

Where can I get tested?

- There are many testing clinics. This website shows the testing clinics in NSW:

- You can just turn up at a public clinic. You don't need to make an appointment.
- Some clinics you can walk into. Other clinics are drive-through clinics.

- Interpreters are available. The clinic can arrange a telephone interpreter when you arrive.
- You can also ask your GP (local doctor) about testing. GPs can arrange testing.

Can children get tested?

- Yes, children can get tested.
- Some clinics may not test very young children. You can call the clinic or check the NSW Health website for age limits:

Does it take long to get tested?

- The test is very quick.
- If the clinic is busy you might need to wait to be tested

How will I get my results?

- Most test results are sent by text message or you can call the number provided by the clinic. Most results are available in less than 24 hours.
- If your test is positive, the health service will call you.

What happens after I get tested?

- You need to self-isolate until you get your results. This means you need to stay at home, away from other people.

What happens if I have COVID-19?

- We will call you, ask you more questions, and tell you what to do.
- You will need to stay home for 14 days, away from other people.
- Most people don't need to go to hospital or a quarantine hotel.
- The health system will support you. If you need treatment in hospital there will no cost to you.
