

How to show proof of your COVID-19 vaccination if you have been vaccinated overseas

If you've received an approved or recognised COVID-19 vaccine while overseas on or after 1 October 2020, and entered Australia with an **Australia Travel Declaration**, you can use this as proof of your COVID-19 vaccination. You can also follow the steps below to have your vaccination recorded on the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR), and get a **COVID-19 digital certificate** or **immunisation history statement** to show as proof of your COVID-19 vaccination.

- 1** Check if the vaccine you received overseas is approved or recognised in Australia (currently Pfizer, AstraZeneca Vaxzevria, Moderna, Janssen-Cilag, Sinovac Coronovac, AstraZeneca Covishield, Sinopharm, and Bharat Biotech).
- 2** If the record of your vaccination is written in another language, have it translated into English. Visit translating.homeaffairs.gov.au to see if you are eligible to use the Free Translating Service.
- 3** Ask a recognised vaccination provider (for example, a GP or a pharmacist) to record your vaccination on the AIR. It will then appear on your COVID-19 digital certificate and immunisation history statement.
- 4** Access your certificate or statement using one of the following methods:

Your Medicare online account through myGov	The Express Plus Medicare mobile app	The Individual Healthcare Identifiers service (if you're not eligible for Medicare)

Note: If you're not eligible for Medicare and need proof of your COVID-19 vaccination online, you'll need an Individual Healthcare Identifier (IHI). You can get an IHI through myGov. For more information go to servicesaustralia.gov.au/covidvaccineproof

- 5** Save your proof of COVID-19 vaccination. You can add your certificate to your Apple Wallet or Google Pay, or save it on the Express Plus Medicare mobile app. You can also add your proof of vaccination to the Service NSW app, to quickly and easily show proof when you check in to venues. Find out how to do this at nsw.gov.au/covidvaccineproof.

Alternatively, you can print a copy of your certificate or statement at home. Download a PDF using your Medicare online account through myGov, or the Express Plus Medicare app, then print this out and carry it with you. A black and white copy will be accepted.

If you're unable to be vaccinated against COVID-19 because of a medical contraindication (which means you can't have any of the COVID-19 vaccines for medical reasons), you can ask your doctor to record this contraindication on the AIR. It will then appear on your certificate and statement.
