**Travel of unaccompanied children to New South Wales, Australia  
Exemption under Public Health (COVID-19 Air Transportation Quarantine)  
Order 2020**

A child under the age of 18 years old and who is travelling without a parent is exempt from conducting their period of mandatory quarantine in a designated quarantine facility following arrival in New South Wales, provided the child is released directly from the airport to the care of their parent(s) or guardian and remains in home isolation for 14 days from the date of arrival in compliance with the *NSW Health Self Isolation Guidelines*.
