## Exemption under Public Health (COVID-19 Air Transportation Quarantine) Order 2020

under the

Public Health Act 2010

I, Brad Hazzard, the Minister for Health and Medical Research, acting under clause 9 of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Air Transportation Quarantine) Order 2020*, do hereby grant the following exemption from that Order :

Children who arrive in NSW as an "unaccompanied child" are exempt from Clause 5(1) of the Order, on condition that:


- (1) The child is released directly from the airport into the custody of their parent or parents;
- (2) The child remains in isolation for the quarantine period and complies with the *NSW Health Self Isolation Guidelines* approved by the Chief Health Officer on 16 March 2020.

In this Exemption:

"Parent" includes a guardian or person with parental responsibility;

"Quarantine period" means the period starting when the child arrives in NSW and ending midnight on the 14th day after that arrival;

"Unaccompanied Child" means a person under 18 years of age who is travelling without the supervision of a parent.
