

Getting a monkeypox (MPXV) vaccination record



How to get a record of your monkeypox (MPXV) vaccination

Proof of your monkeypox vaccination will be recorded on your **immunisation history statement** after you've had your vaccine.

You can get proof of your monkeypox vaccination through:

- **Medicare online account**
- **Express Plus Medicare app**
- **My Health Record**
- **Individual Healthcare Identifiers Service**
- **Australian Immunisation Register**

Please allow up to 12 days for your immunisation record to be updated with your monkeypox vaccination.

Your immunisation record will not be updated with your monkeypox vaccination if you have opted out.



Medicare online account

1. Sign in to your **myGov** account (my.gov.au) and choose **Medicare**
2. From the **Immunisation history** section, select **View immunisation history**
3. Choose your name
4. Click on **View immunisation history statement (PDF)**

Express Plus Medicare app

1. Open the app and sign in
2. From the **Services** section, choose **Immunisation history**
3. Choose your name
4. Click on **View immunisation history statement (PDF)**

My Health Record

You can also get proof of your monkeypox vaccination from My Health Record.

If you already have a My Health Record:

1. Sign in to your **myGov** account (my.gov.au) and choose **My Health Record**
2. Open your My Health Record
3. Access proof of your vaccinations from your **Record Home** page or from your **Immunisations view** page (select **Documents, Immunisations**)

If you don't already have a My Health Record, but you have a Medicare card:

1. Sign in to your **myGov** account (my.gov.au) and link to **My Health Record**
2. Verify your identity and create a My Health Record, making sure to select 'Yes' to include immunisations information (Medicare information) in your My Health Record
3. Open your My Health Record
4. Access proof of your vaccinations from your **Record Home** page or from your Immunisations view page (select **Documents, Immunisations**)

Individual Healthcare Identifiers service (if you don't have a Medicare card)

If you don't have a Medicare card and want to access proof of your vaccinations online, you will need an Individual Healthcare Identifier (IHI). If you don't already have an IHI, you can apply for one online.

Once you have an IHI, you can access proof of your vaccinations through myGov.

1. Sign in to your **myGov** account (my.gov.au) and choose **Individual Healthcare Identifiers service**
2. From the **Services** section, choose **Immunisation History**
3. Click on **View immunisation history statement (PDF)**

Australian Immunisation Register

If you can't get proof of your monkeypox vaccination online, call the

Australian Immunisation Register on **1800 653 809** between 8am-5pm, Monday to Friday.

Ask them to send your **immunisation history statement** to you.

It can take up to 14 days to arrive by mail.
