

Area Co-ordinators Determination

1. INTRODUCTORY

The Health Administration Corporation has determined rates of pay and conditions of employment for Area Co-ordinators pursuant to Section 115 of the Health Services Act, 1997.

2. DEFINITIONS

'Area Co-ordinator' means a person appointed to an administrative position following a review carried out by the Department of Health in 1987. The positions in the 1987 review are contained in Clause 3, Salaries of this Determination.

'Corporation' means the Health Administration Corporation of New South Wales.

'Employer' means the Health Administration Corporation of New South Wales, Health Service or Hospital.

3. SALARIES

Salaries for Area Co-ordinators as defined herein are contained in the Health Professional and Medical Salaries (State) Award.

Following a review in 1987, the Corporation determined the following administrative salaries for Co-ordinators within public hospitals.
