Determination No. 20 of 2009

USE OF PRIVATE MOTOR VEHICLES ON OFFICIAL BUSINESS – TRANSPORT RATE

In accordance with the provisions of section 116A (1) of the Health Services Act 1997, I, Trevor Craft, Deputy Director Workplace Relations and Management of the NSW Department of Health, determine the following:

1. That the rates of allowances used for compensating employees who use their private vehicles on official business as defined in the Department's Official Travel Policy (currently Policy Directive PD2009_016), be adjusted in line with the rates of allowances set by the Department of Premier and Cabinet (DPC) in its Circular C2009-28, effective 1 July 2009, and as amended by DPC from time to time, and
2. The transport allowance rate that no longer appears in DPC circulars and which is referred to in various NSW Health awards, be adjusted in future at 50% of the 2,601cc and over category of the 'official business rate' and from the same operative date of 1 July 2009, and as subsequently amended from time to time, and
3. The NSW Department of Health Intranet site be amended to reflect the new rates of allowances, and
4. The above methodology as set down in paragraphs 1 and 2 above, shall continue to apply until varied, replaced or abolished by way of successor determination.
