2.1 Upper Hunter Shire Council	Upper Hunter Shire Council has written to NSW Health seeking approval to add fluoride to five public water supplies. NSW Health is seeking the advice of the Committee on approval of the three of these supplies currently considered feasible – Scone, Aberdeen and Murrurundi.	The Committee supports the approval of fluoridation for the public water supplies at Scone, Aberdeen and Murrurundi.
2.2 Gunnedah Shire Council	Gunnedah Shire Council has written to NSW Health seeking approval to add fluoride to the Gunnedah water supply. NSW Health is seeking the Committee’s advice on this proposal.	The Committee supports the approval of fluoridation for the public water supply at Gunnedah.
2.3 Bega Valley Shire Council	Bega Valley Shire Council has written to NSW Health seeking approval to add fluoride to all unfluoridated public water supplies in the Shire. NSW Health is seeking the advice of the committee on approval of the two of these supplies currently considered feasible – Tantawanglo/Kiah and Brogo Bermagui.	The Committee supports the approval of fluoridation for the public water supplies at Tantawanglo/Kiah and Brogo Bermagui.

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2.4 Oberon Council	Oberon Council has written to NSW Health seeking approval to add fluoride to the Oberon water supply. NSW Health is seeking the Committee's advice on this proposal.	The Committee supports the approval of fluoridation for the public water supply at Oberon.
