## Kanga Cricket

The most popular version of Kanga Cricket is Kanga Pairs.

#### THE TEAM

- 1. Divide a group into pairs 5 pairs is ideal, minimum 3, maximum 7. If you have a class of 30, create 3 games.
- 2. Pair 1 will be batters, Pair 2 will take turns to bowl and wicketkeep. Pairs 3, 4 and 5 will field.

#### THE FIELD

- 1. The playing area can be any reasonably flat surface. The length of the pitch should suit the age of the children starting at 12 14 m for U10s.
- 2. A set of wickets is placed at each end of the pitch.
- 3. The boundary should be at least 20 metres from the pitch. Fielders should stand at least 10 metres from the batters.

### **EQUIPMENT**

2 Kanga bats and a Kanga ball. No gloves, pads or helmets.
