

Respiratory syncytial virus (RSV) vaccines and immunisation products



NSW RSV Prevention Program

There are 3 RSV immunisation products available to prevent RSV in infants and older adults. To prevent administration errors:

- Ensure you are administering the correct vaccine or immunisation product for your patient.
- Consider storing vaccines for different cohorts on separate shelves to prevent errors and using the NSW Health vaccine fridge basket stickers to clearly label the RSV products.
