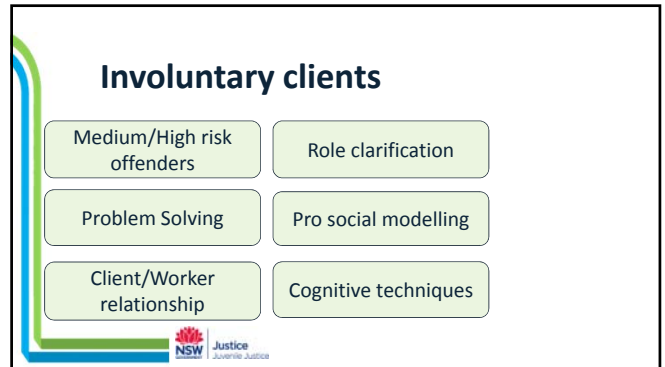
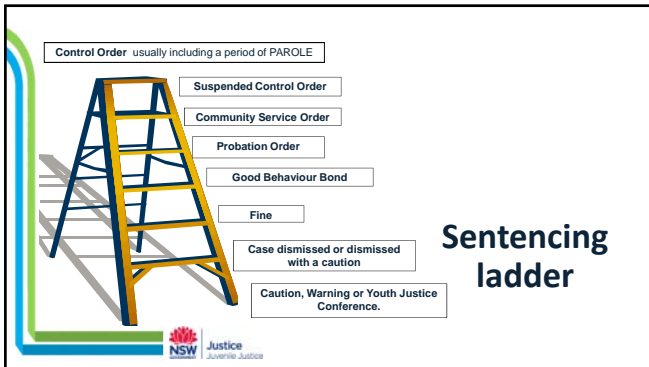
291 In custody	24 Females (8%)

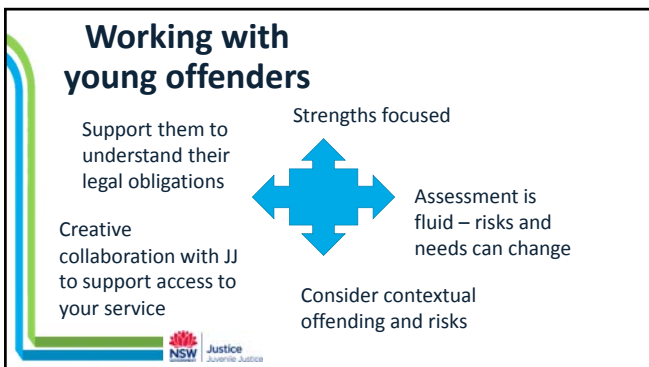

- Anti social attitudes and cognitions **
 - Anti social associates
 - History of anti social behaviour
 - Anti social personality pattern
- NSW Justice Juvenile Justice

- Other criminogenic risks**
- **Problematic family circumstances** - (*inadequate monitoring by carers, inappropriate discipline, poor relationships, antisocial family values etc*)
 - **Problems at work, school** (*irregular attendance, social problems, low achievement etc*)
 - **Problems with use of spare time** (*little participation in organised/positive activity, limited positive interests etc*)
 - **Substance abuse** – *AOD use, interfering with life, linked to offending etc*)
