DESIGN TEAM APPOINTED FOR LISMORE BASE HOSPITAL REDEVELOPMENT

Planning has kicked off for the Lismore Base Hospital redevelopment project with the appointment of the lead design team, the Minister for Health and Minister for Medical Research, Jillian Skinner, and the Member for Lismore, Thomas George, announced today.

Mrs Skinner said that the NSW Government has provided funding to progress planning, design and documentation.

“This supports the \$10 million election commitment made by the O’Farrell Government towards the Lismore Base and the Byron hospitals redevelopments,” Mrs Skinner said.

“Planning works can now proceed, as the consultant team has been selected,” she said.

Mr George said that extensive consultation will now be undertaken with relevant stakeholders from the community, nurses, doctors, health professionals and the Northern NSW Local Health District.

“It’s exciting that we’re getting on with the job with of delivering on an election commitment that means so much to our community,” Mr George said.

“We’re now one step closer to the much needed redevelopment we have long advocated for,” he said.

Aurora Projects has been appointed as the project manager and Hassell have been appointed architects for the project. Altus Page Kirkland has been appointed as the project’s cost manager.
