NSW Health has a long and proud history of celebrating Patient Experience Week, hosting events annually since 2013.

In 2021, NSW Health launched <u>Elevating the Human Experience – Our Guide to Action</u>. Last year, we celebrated the Power of Storytelling, and NSW Health was announced as the winner of The Beryl Institute's global <u>Organisational Innovation Award</u> for Human Experience.

We listened to the voices of NSW Health staff and consumers and have rebranded Patient Experience Week to Human Experience Week. This change reinforces that the experiences of our patients, their families and carers cannot be separated from the experiences of our carergivers (staff and volunteers).

Human Experience Week builds on previous years, celebrating and honouring those who impact the experiences of all people who come in contact with NSW Health.



Over five days, the Division of Health System Strategy and Patient Experience, Local Health Districts, Speciality Health networks, agencies and pillars, staff and consumers will come together to host in-person events, alongside a virtual program focusing on the importance of love, belonging and healing.




