Approval of an Organisation to provide anaphylaxis first aid training

1) Authorisation

This instrument approves a registered training organisation to be recognised to provide first aid training in the use of adrenaline for the treatment of anaphylaxis.

2) Definitions

registered training organisation means a provider registered by:

- the Australian Skills Quality Authority to deliver nationally recognised vocational education and training in Australia, or
- the Western Australian Training Accreditation Council, or
- the Victorian Registration and Qualifications Authority

3) Validity

This instrument commences on the day it is signed and dated, and expires on commencement of the *Medicines, Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Act 2022* or otherwise on a date that this instrument is cancelled.
