

POISONS AND THERAPEUTIC GOODS ACT 1966

AUTHORITY

I, JUDITH MACKSON, Chief Pharmacist, a duly appointed delegate of the Secretary, NSW Health, make this instrument pursuant to clauses 170 and 171 of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008* (PTGR), for the purpose of section 10(2)(b) of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Act 1966* (PTGA) and clause 17 of the PTGR.

Authority – Supply of the Schedule 3 substance salbutamol by a paramedic or flight nurse employed by NSW Ambulance to another person.

1) Authority

This instrument authorises:

- a) a paramedic employed by NSW Ambulance who is registered as a paramedic under the *Health Practitioner Regulation National Law (NSW) No 86a*, and
- b) a flight nurse employed by NSW Ambulance to supply salbutamol in a metered aerosol delivering 100 micrograms or less of salbutamol per metered dose for the purpose of section 10(2)(b) of the PTGA and clause 17 of the PTGR, subject to the conditions below.

2) Conditions

1. The paramedic or flight nurse may only supply salbutamol to a person being treated by the paramedic or flight nurse for the purposes of their employment with NSW Ambulance.
2. The paramedic or flight nurse may only supply salbutamol to the person prior to transportation to hospital.
3. The supply by the paramedic or flight nurse is limited to one salbutamol metered aerosol per patient.
4. The paramedic or flight nurse must make a record of the supply to the patient.

3) Publication

This authority will be published in the NSW Health website.

4) Duration

This instrument commences on signature and expires on 30 September 2023, unless earlier revoked.
