

POISONS AND THERAPEUTIC GOODS ACT 1966

Supply of therapeutic goods by automatic machine

I, DAVID NG, Chief Pharmacist, a duly appointed delegate of the Minister for Health, issue this order pursuant to section 36(4) of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Act 1966* (the Act), subject to conditions.

Order to allow supply of therapeutic regulated goods by automatic machine

1. Exemption

This order exempts a person who installs an automatic machine or supplies the following regulated good by means of an automatic machine; or a person who occupies or controls premises where an automatic machine is installed for the purpose of storing and supplying the following regulated good:

<i>HIV self-testing (HIVST) kits</i>

from the operation of section 36(1) and section 36(2) of the Act.

2. Conditions

- a. The product must be supplied only in the original ARTG packs (including batch numbers and expiry dates) labelled and packaged as approved by the Commonwealth Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA).
- b. The product must be supplied from automatic machines that are part of the NSW Health HIV self-testing (HIVST) kits Vending Machine Program ('MyTest').

3. Validity

This order commences on the day it is signed and dated and remains in force until revoked.
