EXEMPTION

Exemption from the requirement on a pharmacist to keep a prescription

I, BRUCE BATTYE, Director Pharmaceutical Operations, a duly appointed delegate of the Secretary, NSW Health, make this instrument pursuant to clause 89(3) of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008* (NSW) [the Regulation] for the purposes of clause 89(1) of the Regulation. Pursuant to clause 89(4) of the Regulation, the authorisation is granted subject to conditions.

Exemption from the requirement on a pharmacist to keep a prescription

1 Exemption

This instrument exempts pharmacists from the requirement to keep a prescription for the Schedule 8 drug of addiction methylphenidate.

2 Conditions

The exemption only applies to a pharmacist that is unable to supply the above listed drugs of addiction due to a supply shortage to facilitate the ability for another pharmacist to supply the medicine.

3 Revocation of existing Exemption

The exemption from the requirement on a pharmacist to keep a prescription for the Schedule 8 drug of addiction methylphenidate by the Acting Director Pharmaceutical Operations dated 9 January 2025 is cancelled.

4 Validity

This exemption commences on the day it is signed and dated and expires on 31 December 2025, or otherwise on a date that this exemption is cancelled.
